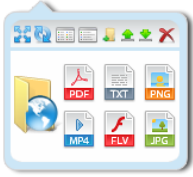

## About File Manager Add-on



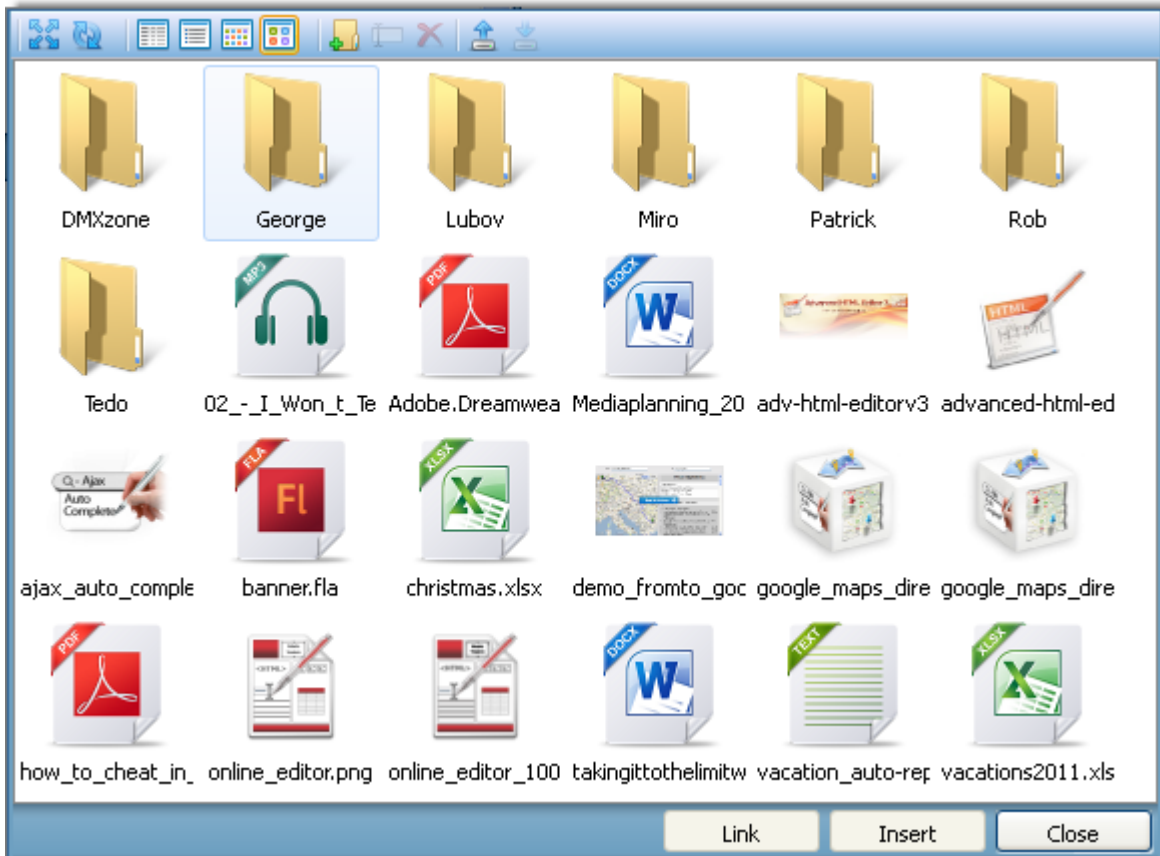
Manage a complete file library directly in your **Advanced HTML Editor 3**? It's now possible with the **File Manager Add-on**, which allows you and your users to upload, delete, rename, download files and folders with a few mouse clicks.

**Drag** one or many files from your personal folders and **drop** to upload them automatically into the manager (Firefox & Chrome) and if you choose to show **thumbnails for the images**, the File Manager will generate a small thumbnail preview server side on the fly.

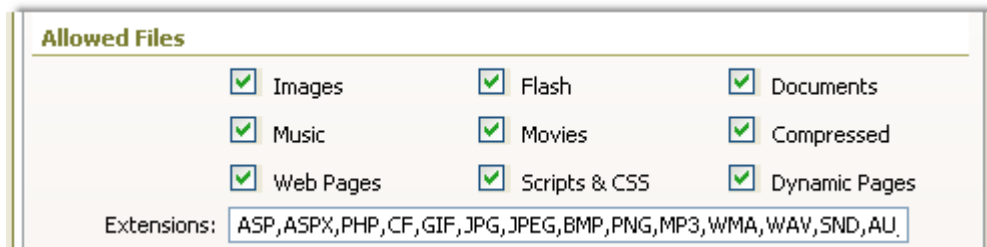
The **File Manager Add-on** is **fully secured** and the file views load **mighty fast** due to extensive usage of Ajax technology and CSS Sprites, and the amazing integration with the **Advanced HTML Editor 3**, which even matches the skin and style.

## Features in Detail

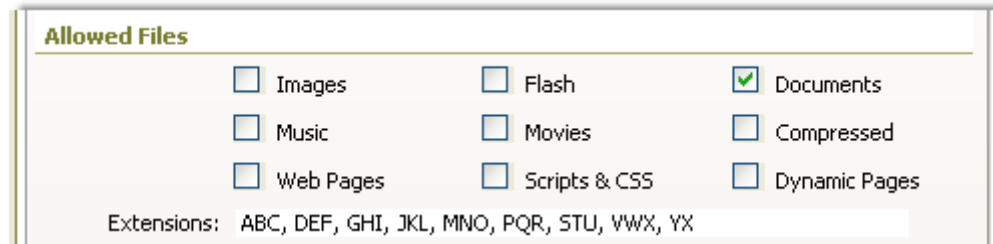
- **Great support for images, web/dynamic pages, documents, music, movies, compressed, scripts & CSS files** - You can upload any file to your File Manager in [Advanced HTML Editor 3](#)



- **Allow only specific file types to be shown and managed** - You can choose whether to show or hide files from your users in the File Manager.



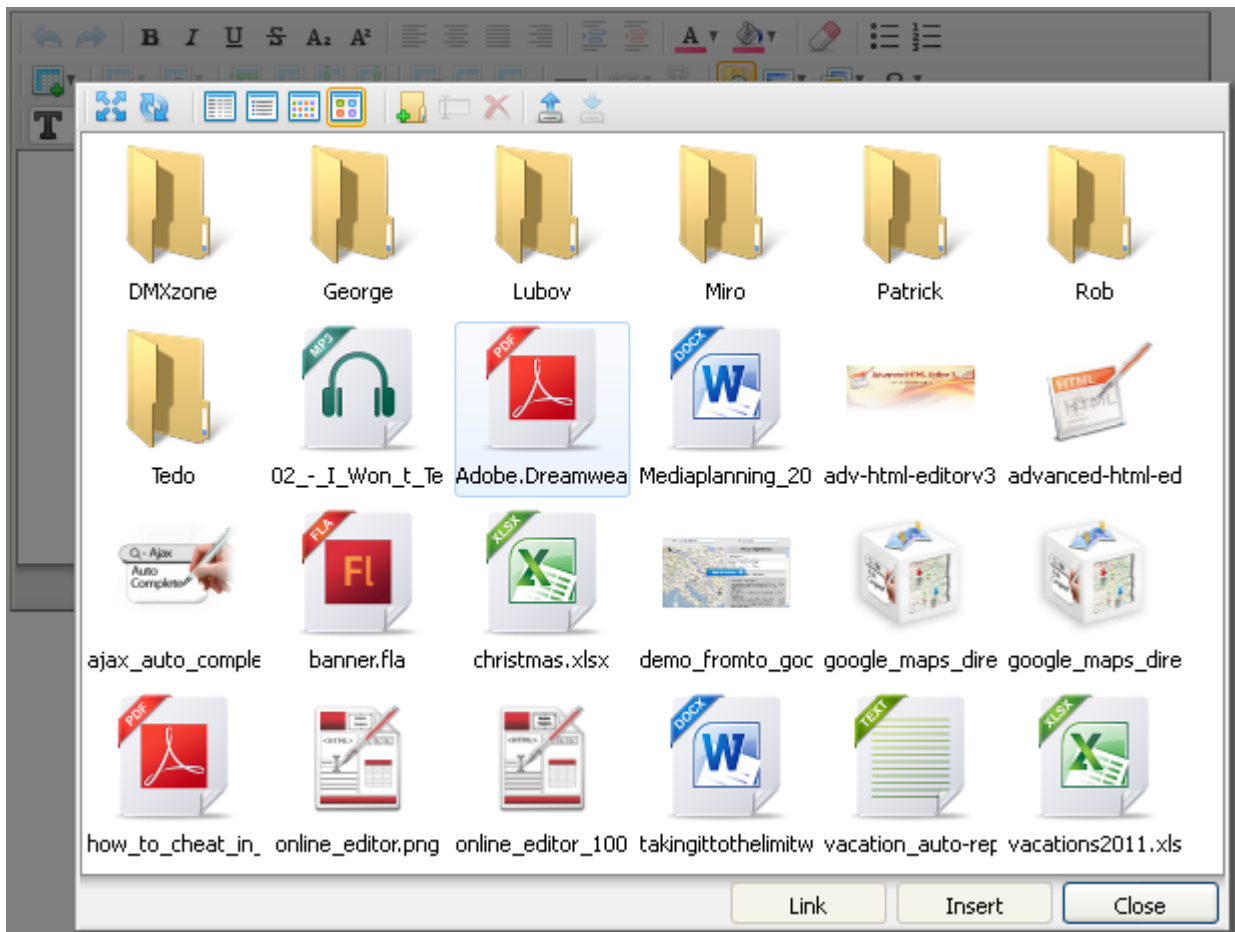
- **Custom Files** - You can make your File Manager support any custom file type, by entering it comma separated.

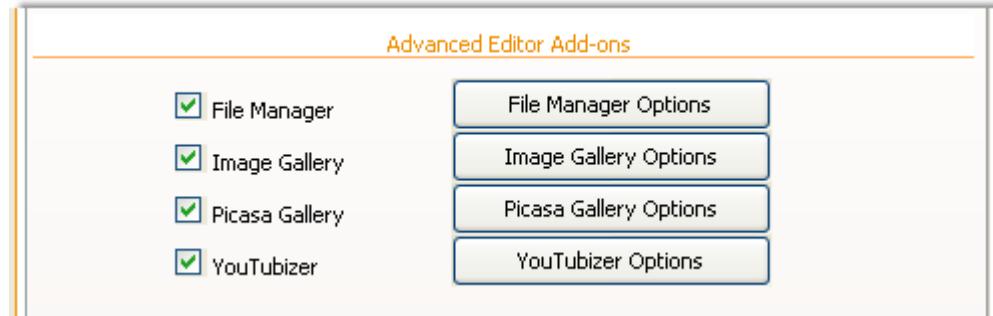


- **Ajax based file manager** - All file manager actions like uploading, adding new folder, editing and delete are all done asynchronous through Ajax, so your manager is super fast and very responsible.

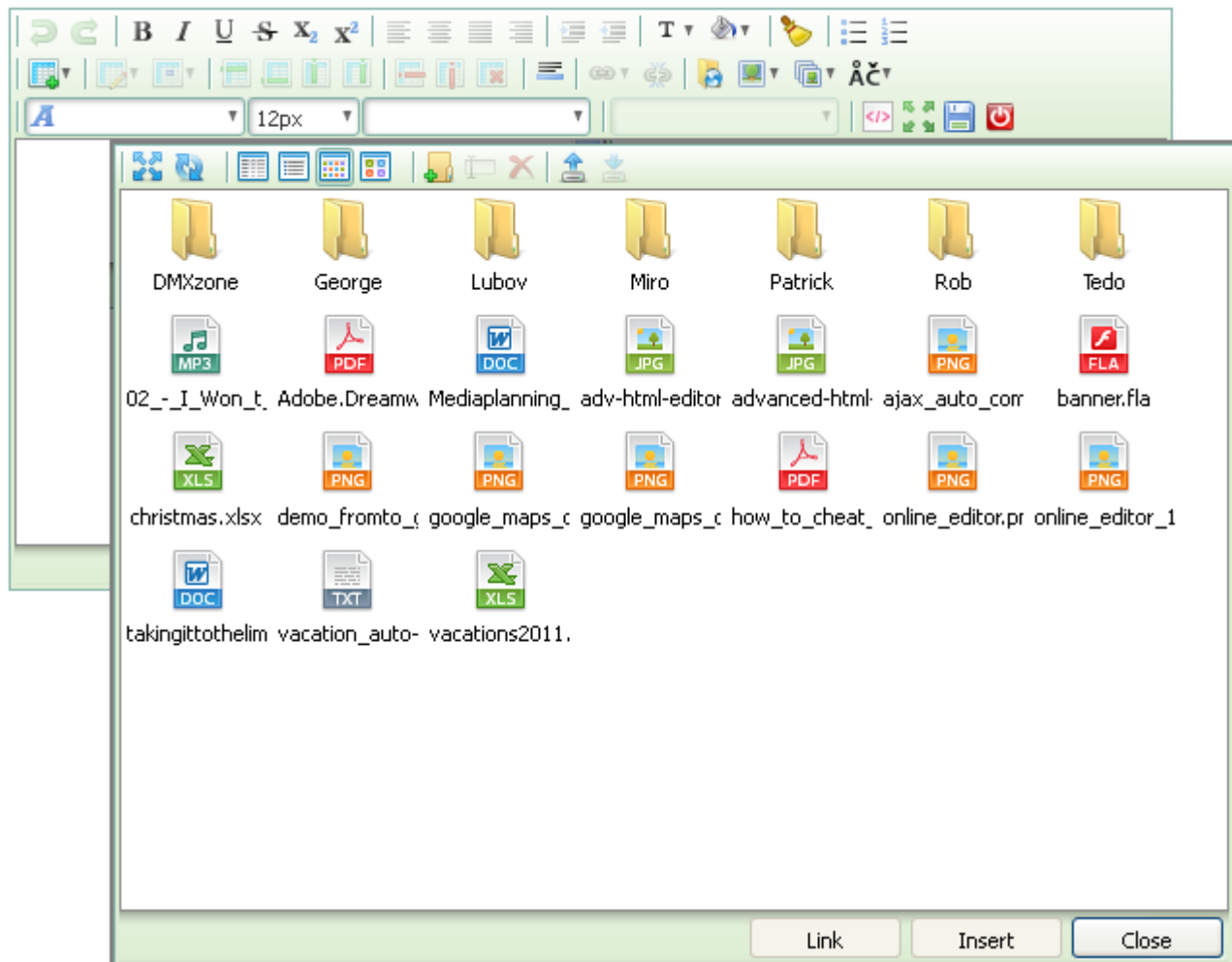


- **Great Advanced HTML Editor 3 Integration** - The **File Manager Add-on** is fully integrated into the [Advanced HTML Editor 3](#), with the same beautiful style.

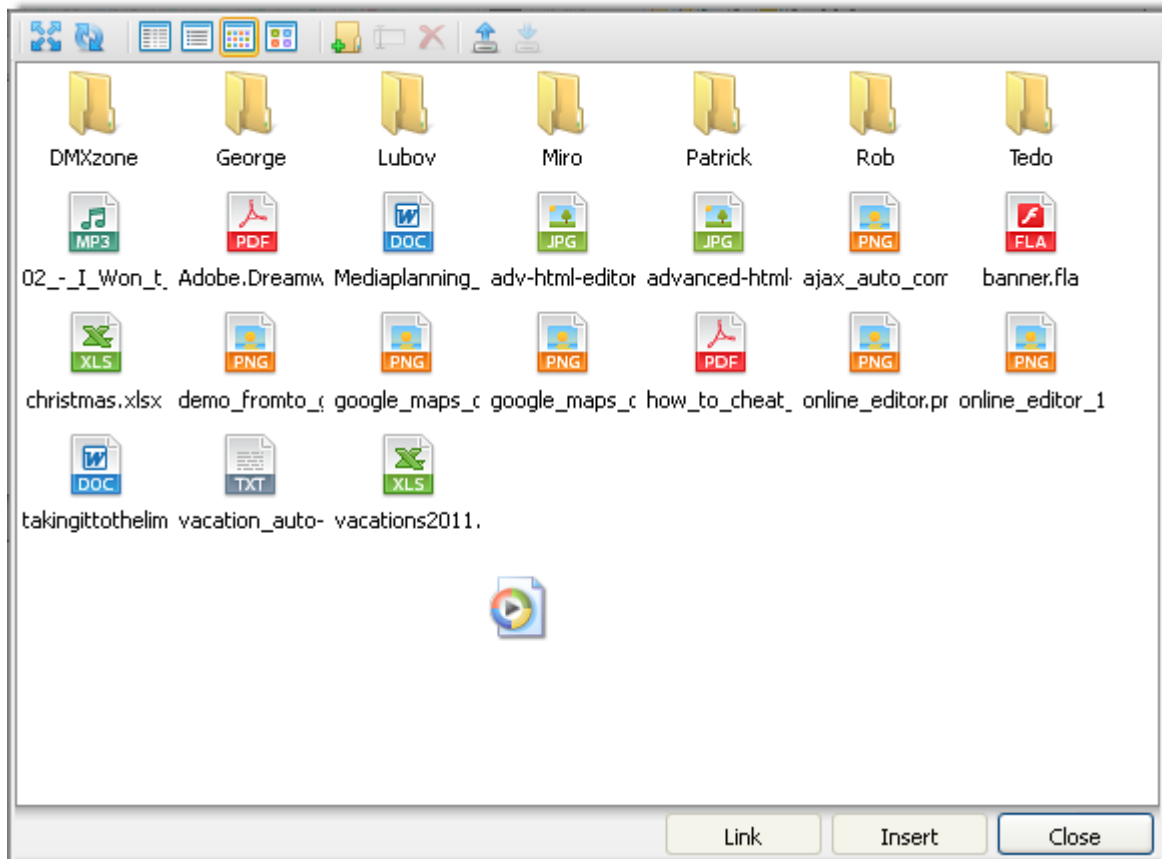


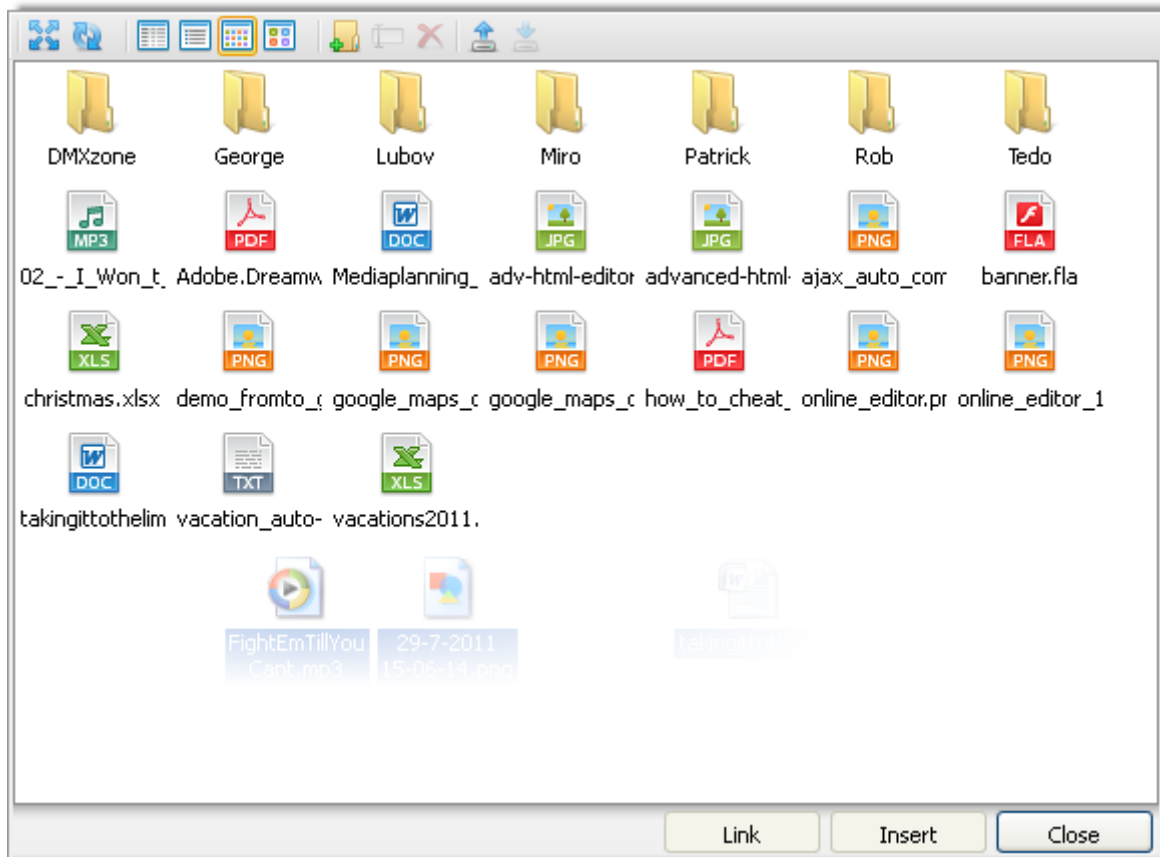


- **Fully integrated in the editor style and skin** - The skin of the File Manager Add-on always matches the selected editor skin.

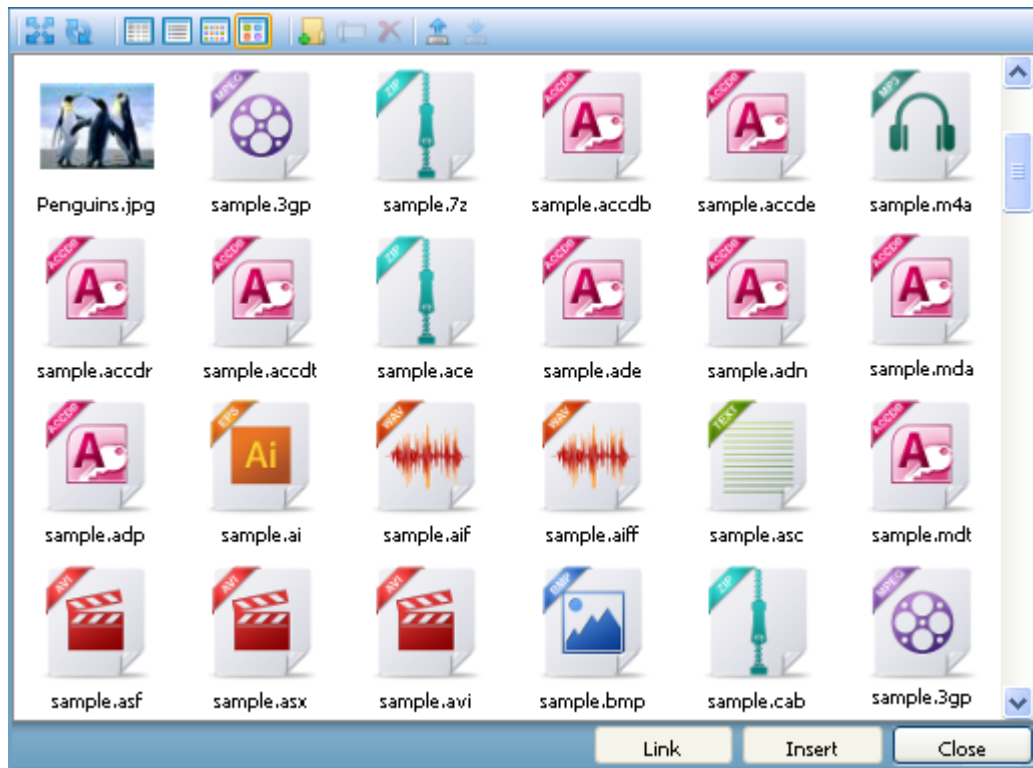


- **Full integrated Ajax Multi Upload with Drag & Drop** (Firefox and Chrome) - Drag one or many files from your personal folders and drop to upload them automatically into the manager.



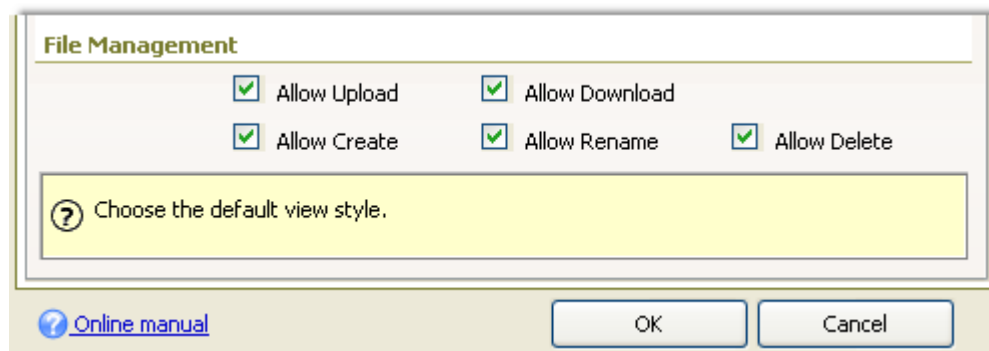
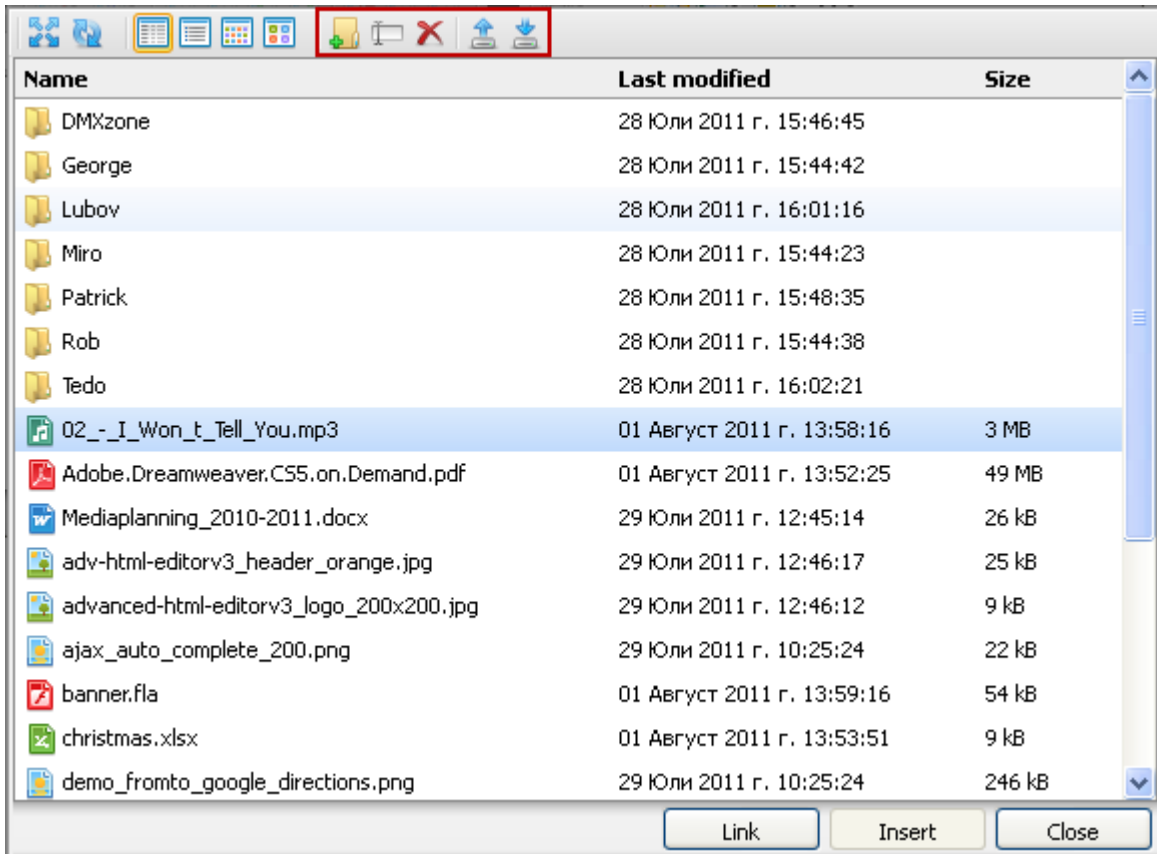


- **Automatic On the Fly Thumbnail Generation** - When you choose to show thumbnails for the images, the File Manager will automatically, on the fly generate a small thumbnail preview server side. So you don't have to download the full image. This makes the File Manager thumbnail view very fast!

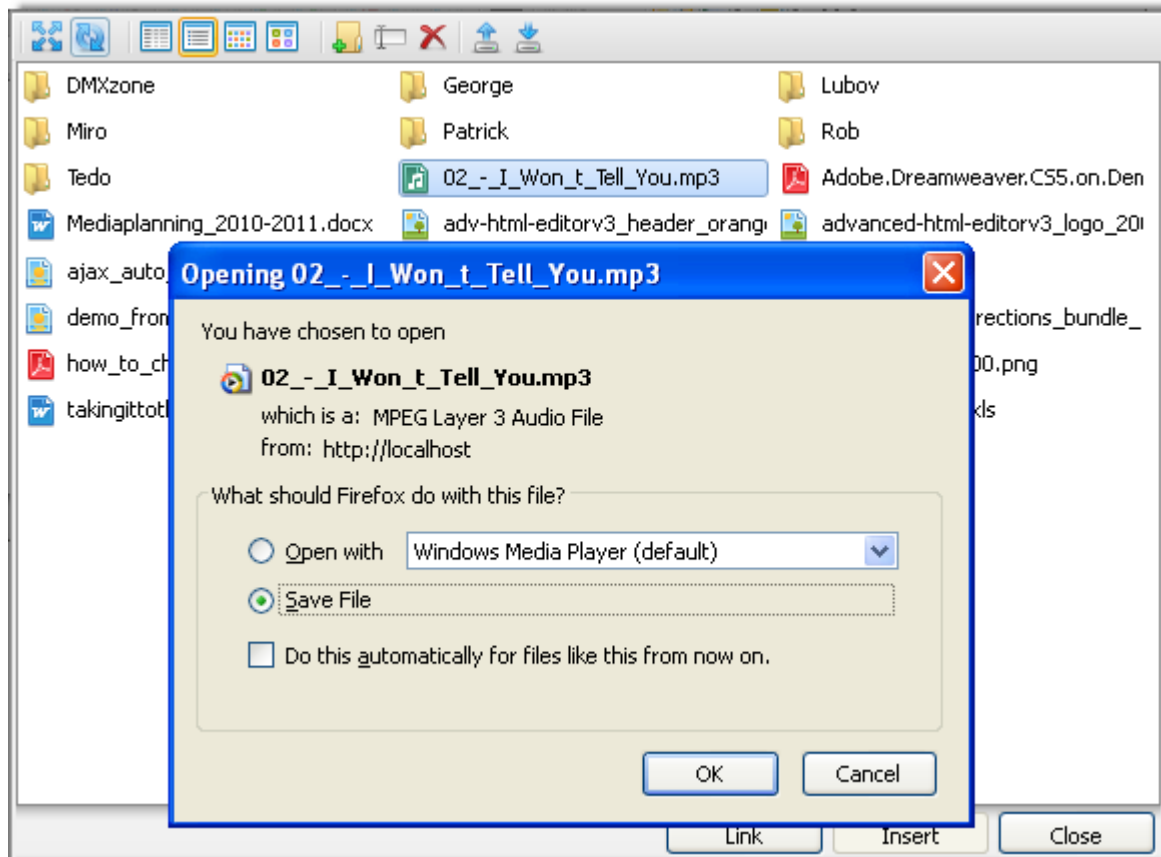




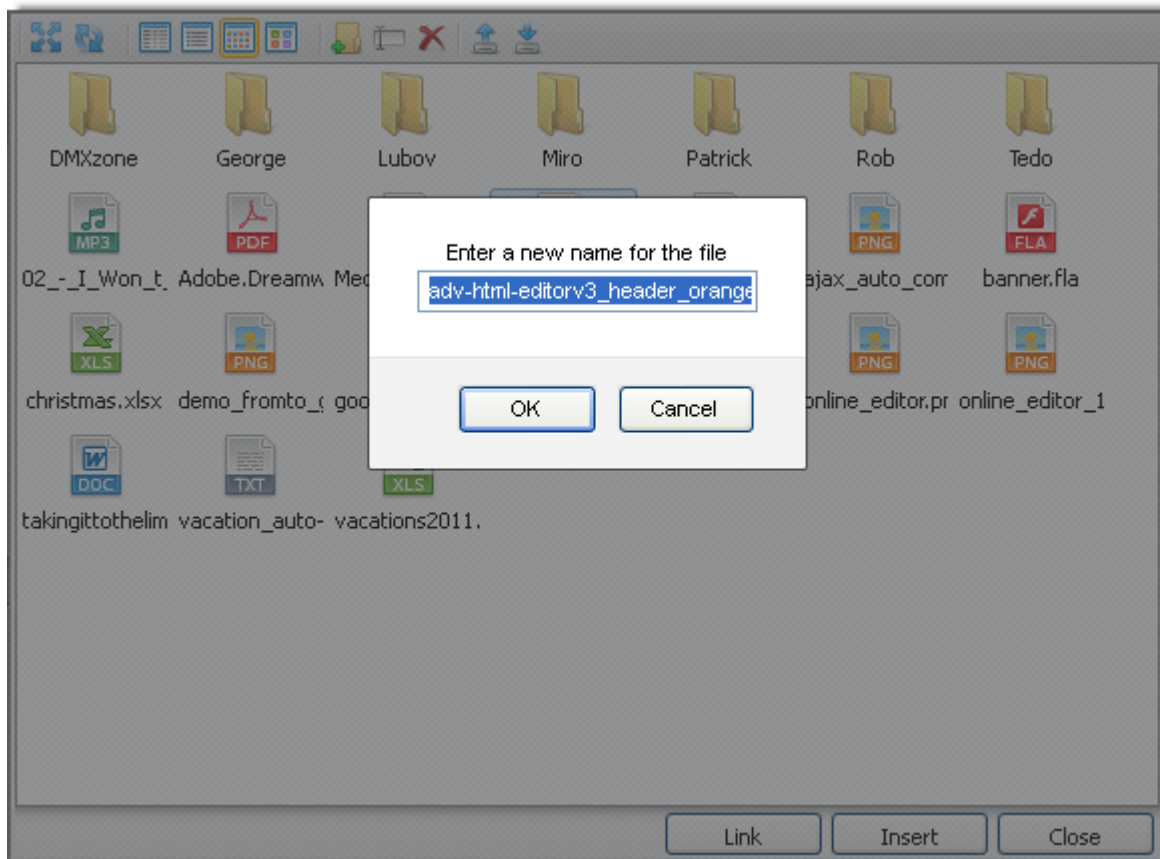
- **Fully Manageable** - You can allow the user to manage the files - Add, remove and download files, create new folders and rename them.



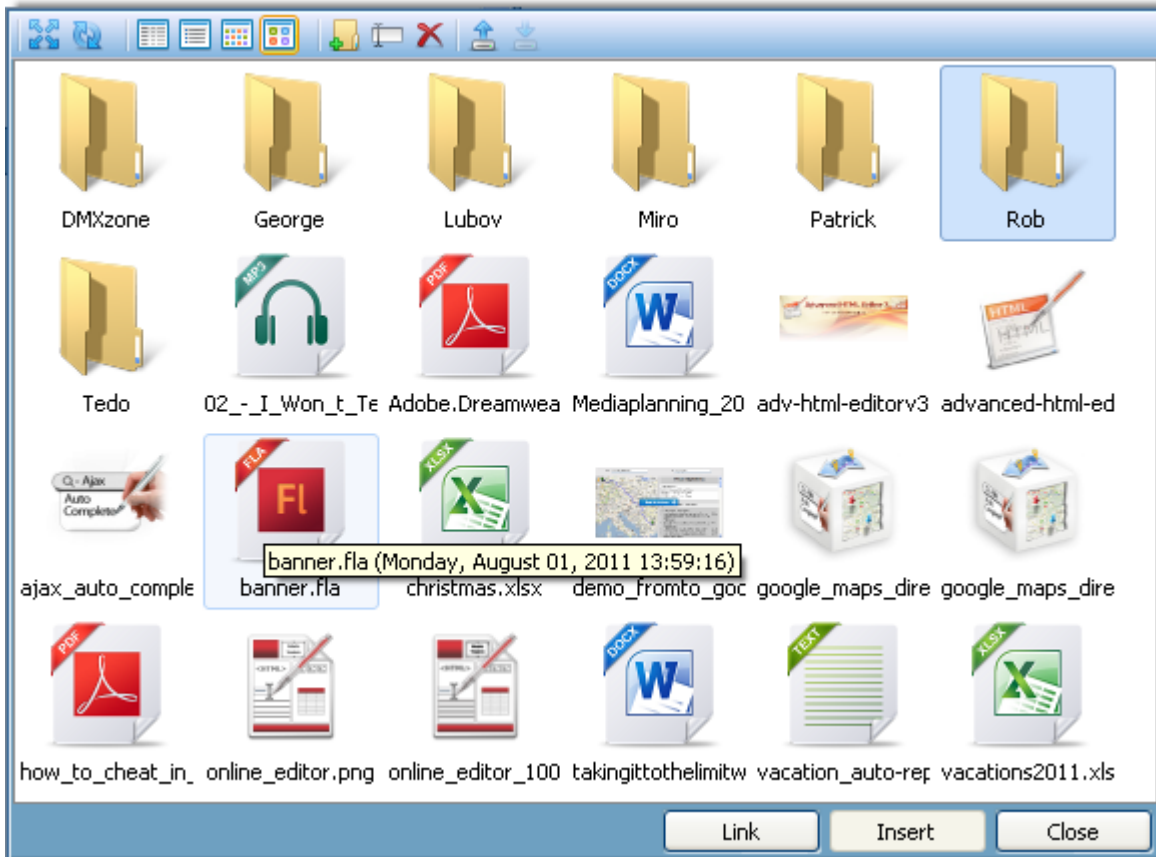
- **File Downloads** - Next to the upload files in the File Manager you can also chose to download directly any file from it!



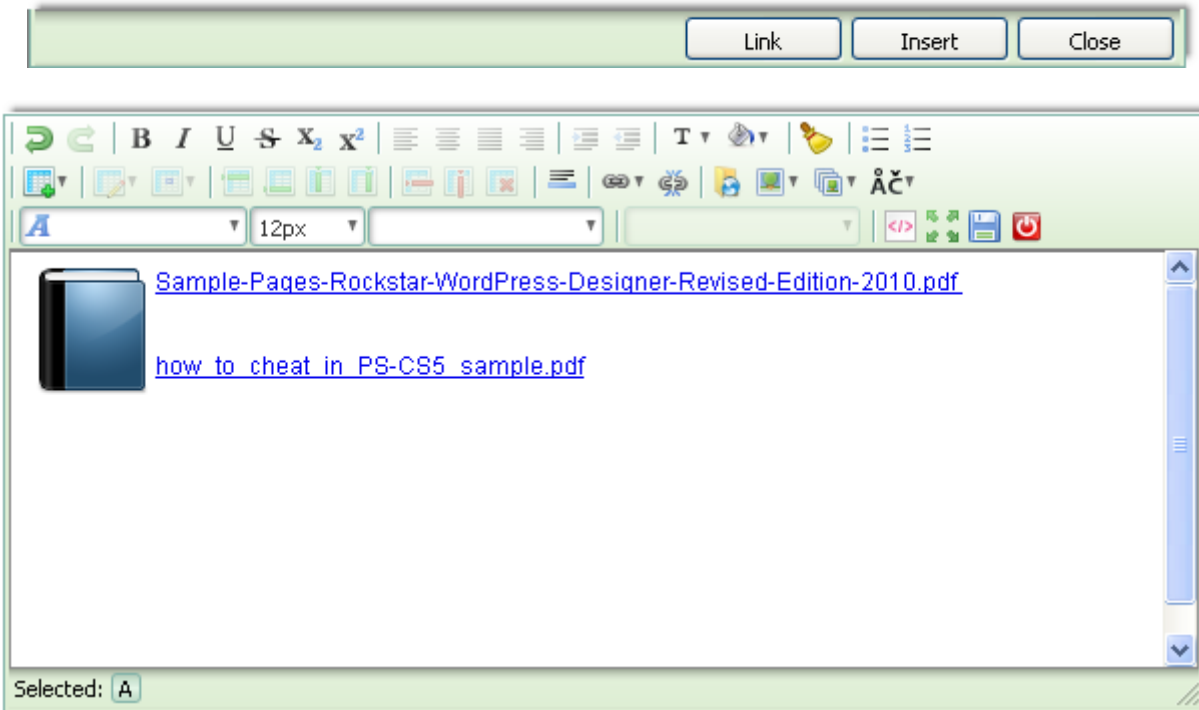
- **Edit file names and folders** - Once the editing is allowed you can rename the files and folders at any time.



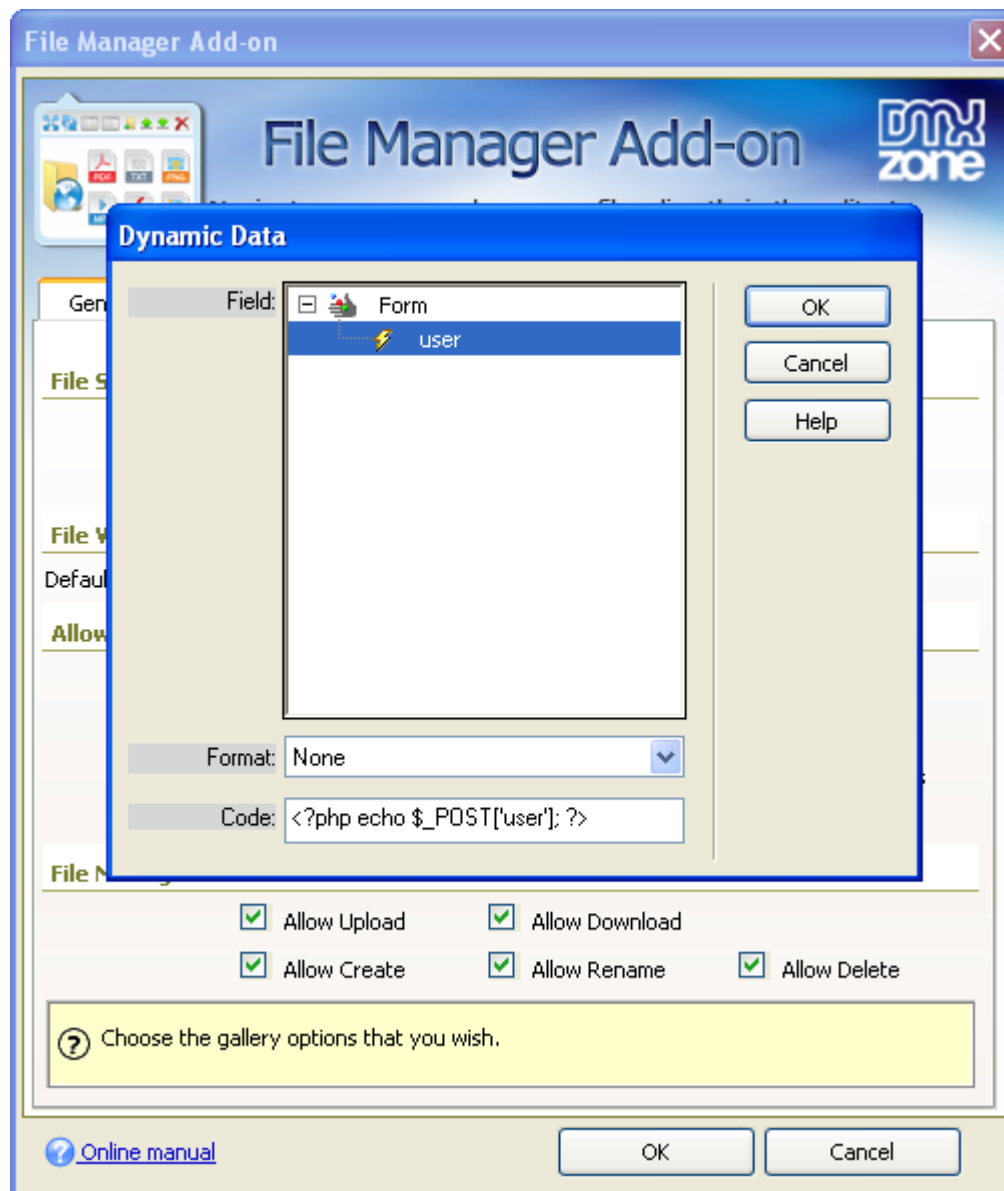
- **Image Info Tooltips** - Display more detailed file information.



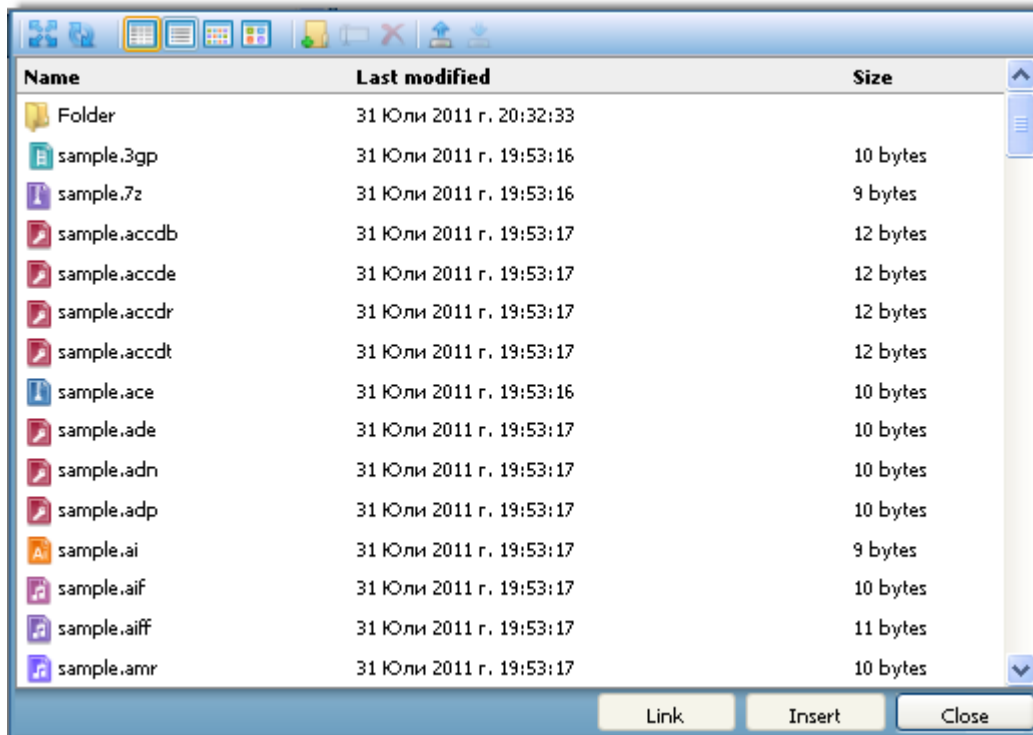
- **Link or Insert files directly in the Adv HTML Editor 3** - With the File Manager, next to managing the files, you can also select any file and choose if you want to link to it or insert it in the current editor. If you have selected existing link or image in the editor, it will be edited otherwise new will be inserted.



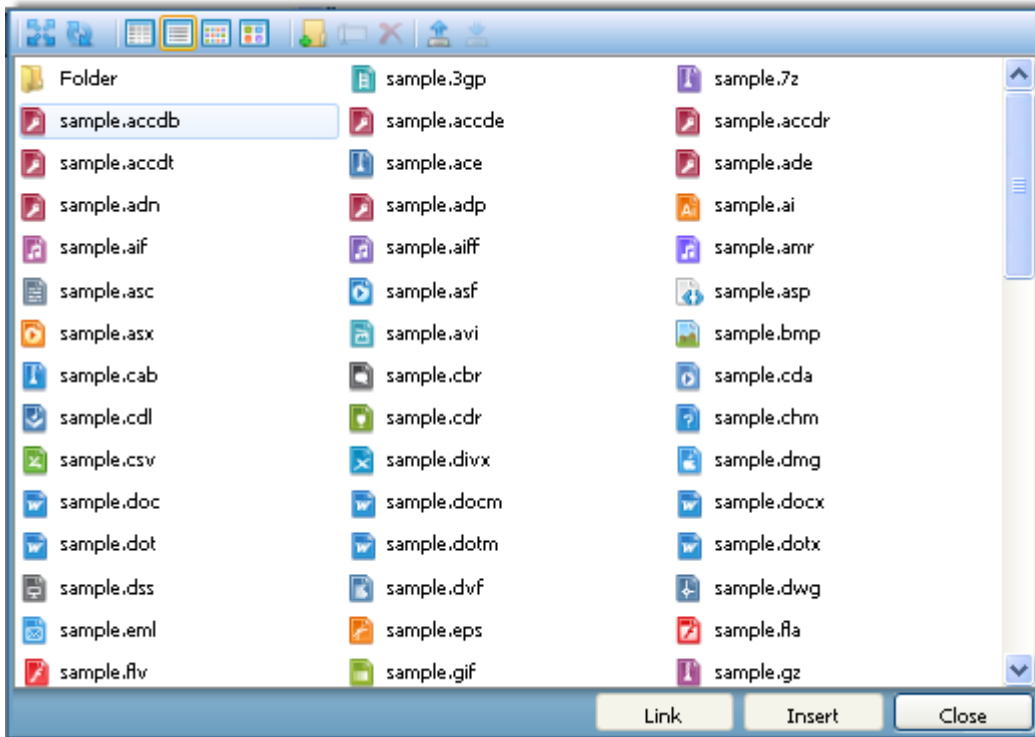
- **Dynamic folders** - You can use dynamic data to make dynamic folders.



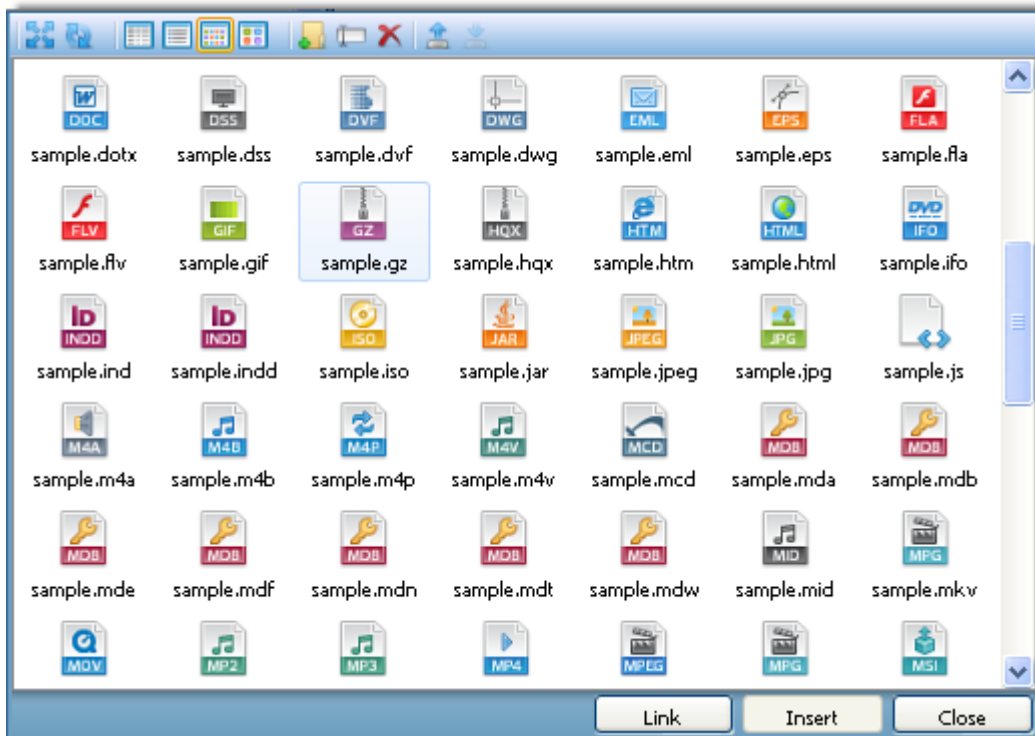
- **CSS Sprites** - All preview icons are stored in a CSS Sprite image that makes the File Manager views load mighty fast as it needs to download just that single, well optimized image.
- **Great File Views** - Chose between detailed, list or thumbnails view.
  - **Detail View** - In the detail files view you have small files icons, last modified information and size.



- **List View** - In the list view you have an ordered array of your files.

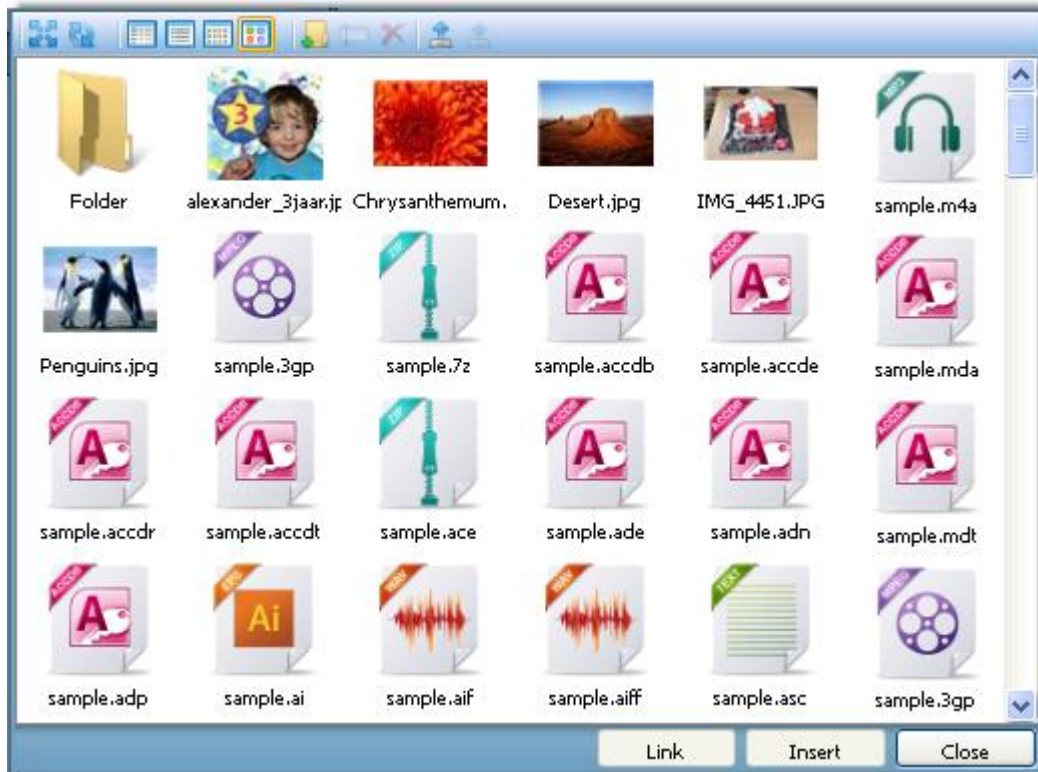


- **Icon View** - You can preview your files types with the suitable icon.





- **Thumbnail View** - In the thumbnail view you have a large icon for any files type and the image thumbnails are automatically generated on the fly.



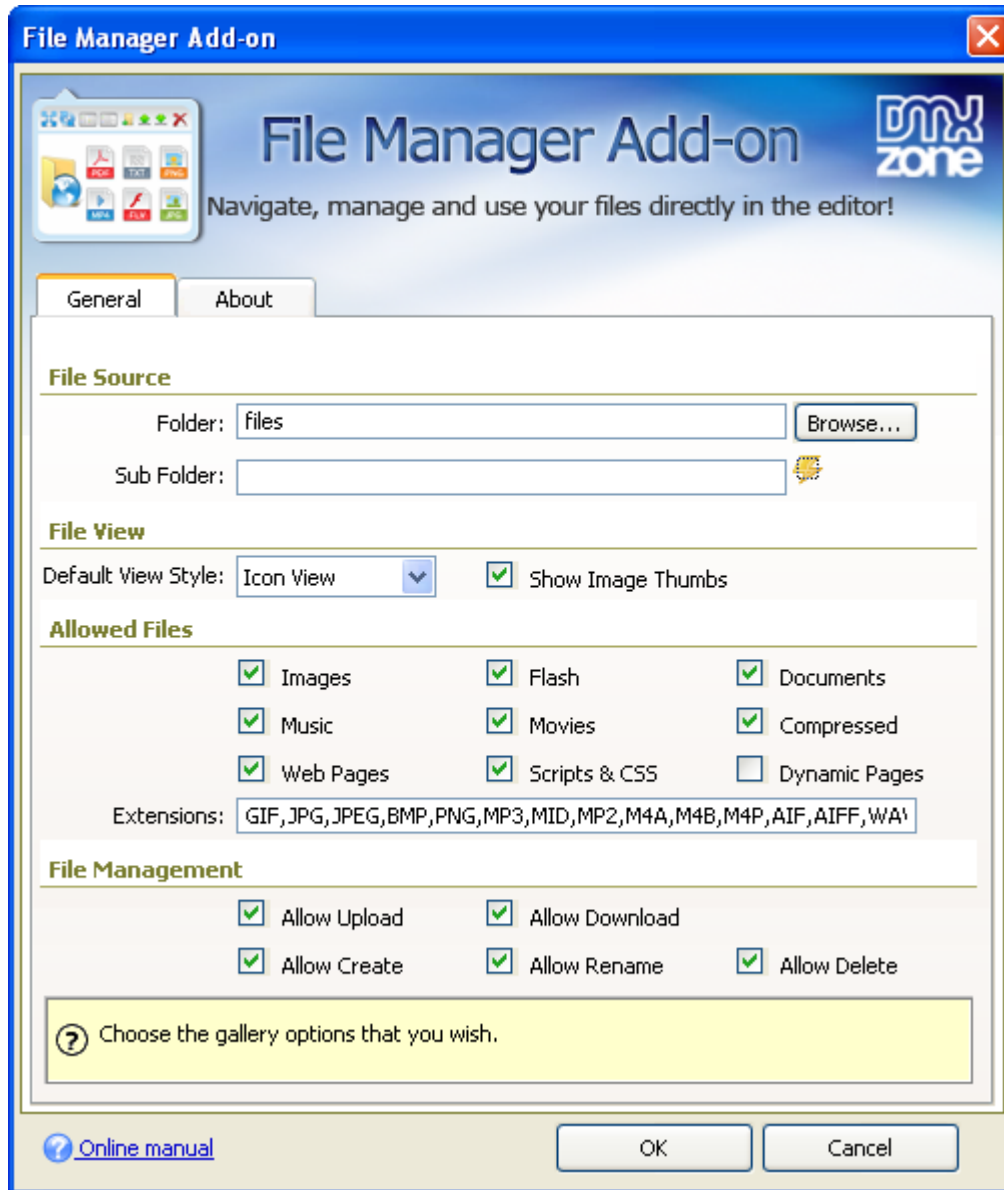
- **Secure File Manager** - The **File Manager Add-on** has been designed to keep your files save with the choice to make visible only certain folders or files types.
- **Support for all latest browsers** - All modern browsers are supported (IE8+ FF 3.6+, Safari 5+, Chrome 10+, Opera 10).



- **Fully jQuery powered** - Works with the latest jQuery 1.4.4



- **Great Dreamweaver Integration** - Interactive dialog in Dreamweaver with all the options you'll need.

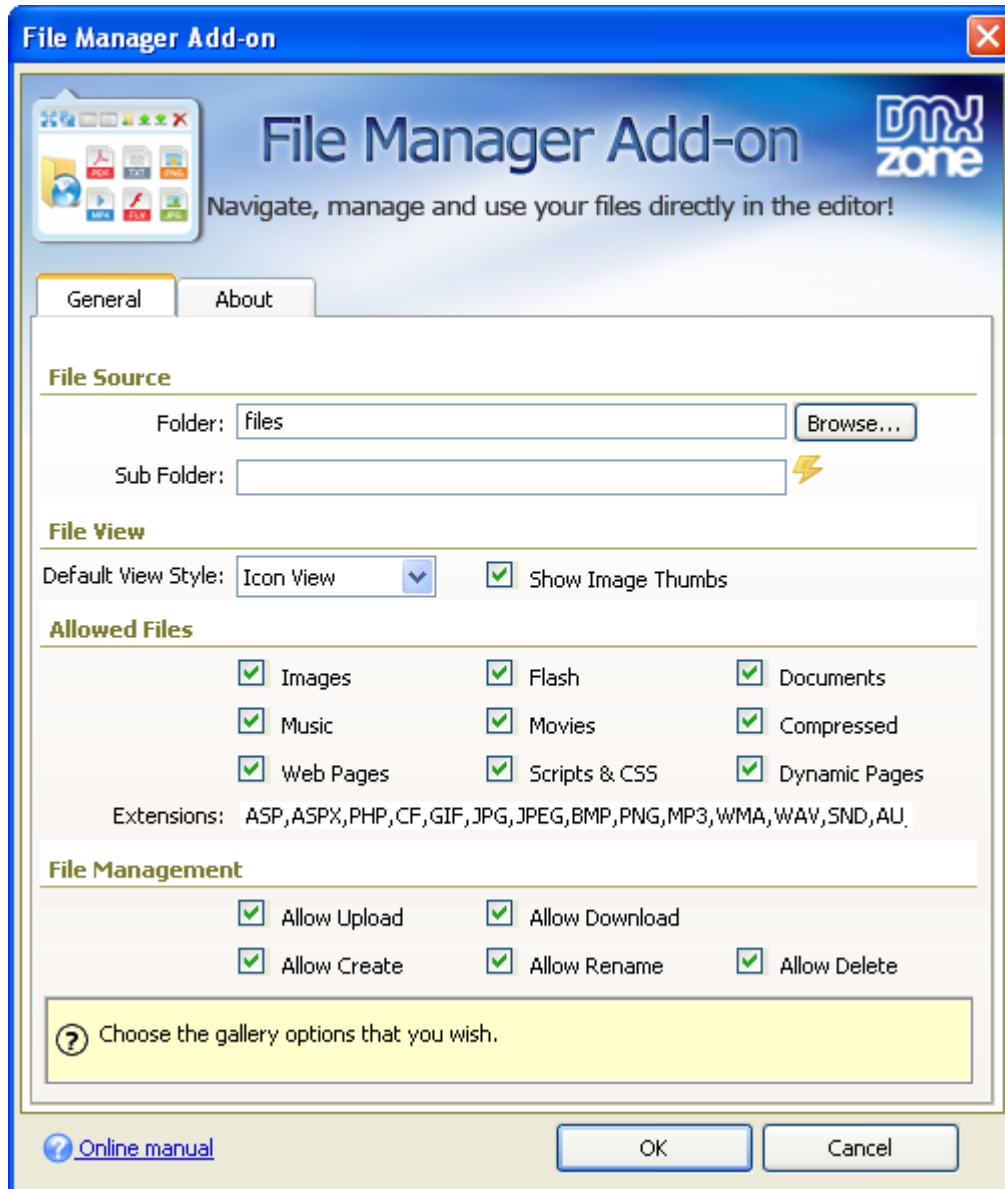
Open the .mxp file (the extension manager should start-up) and install the extension.

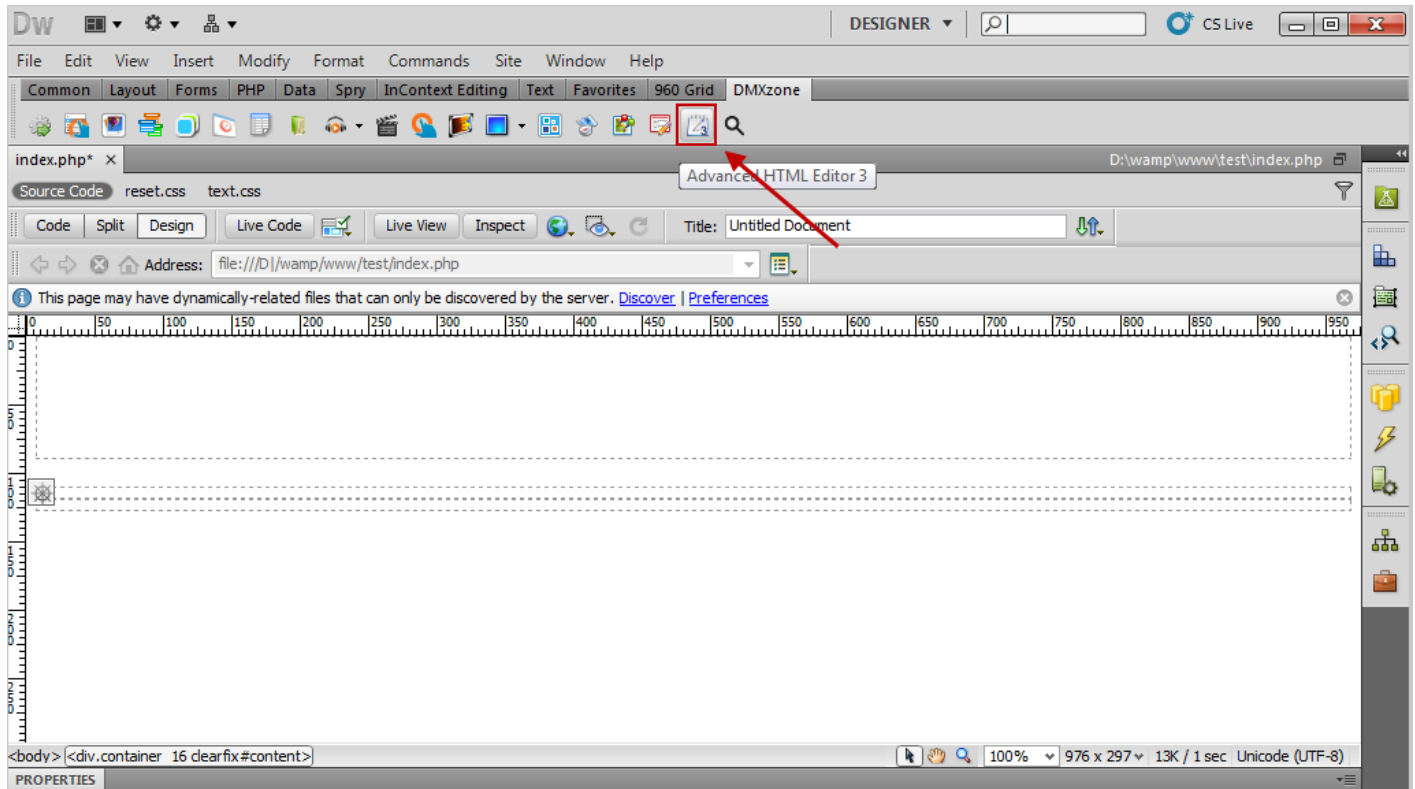

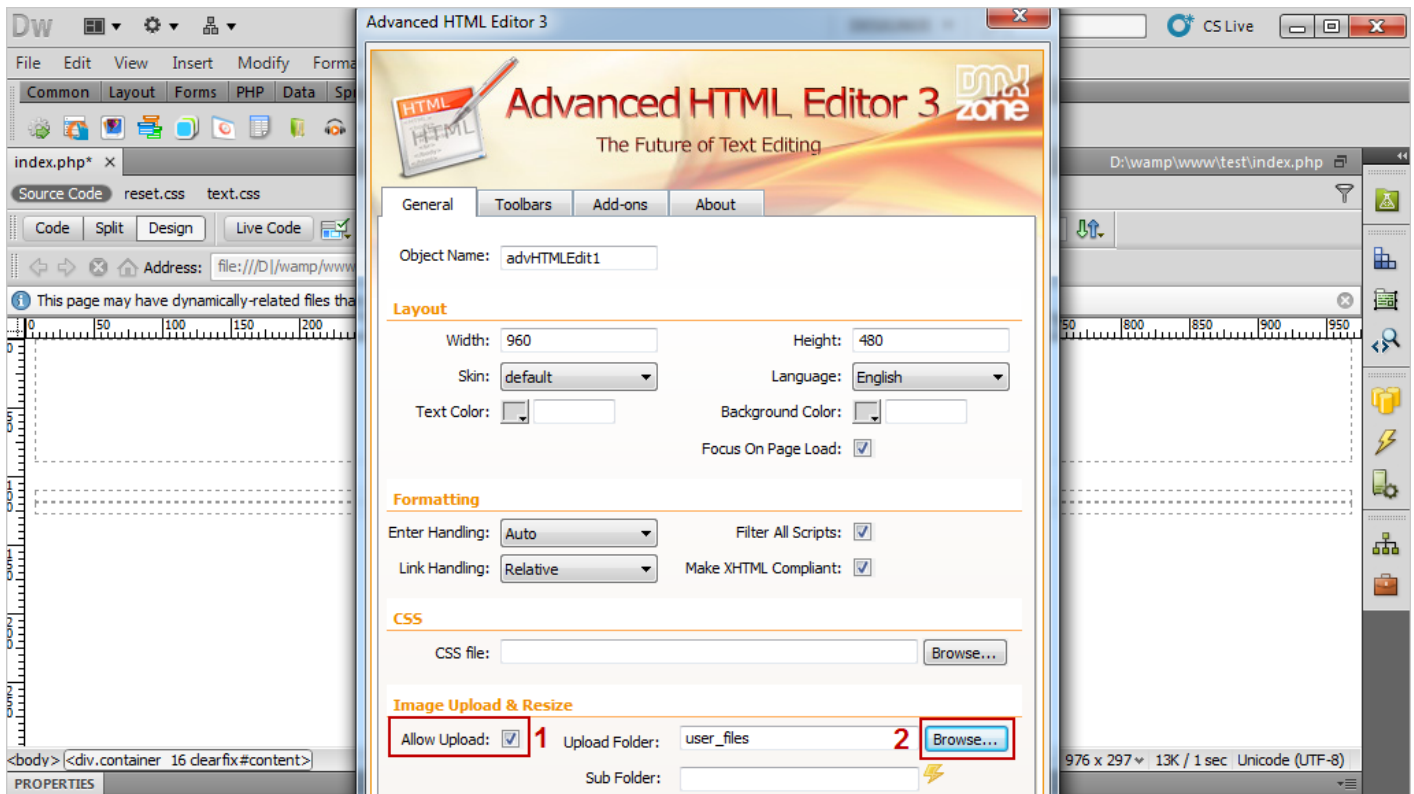


## How to do it

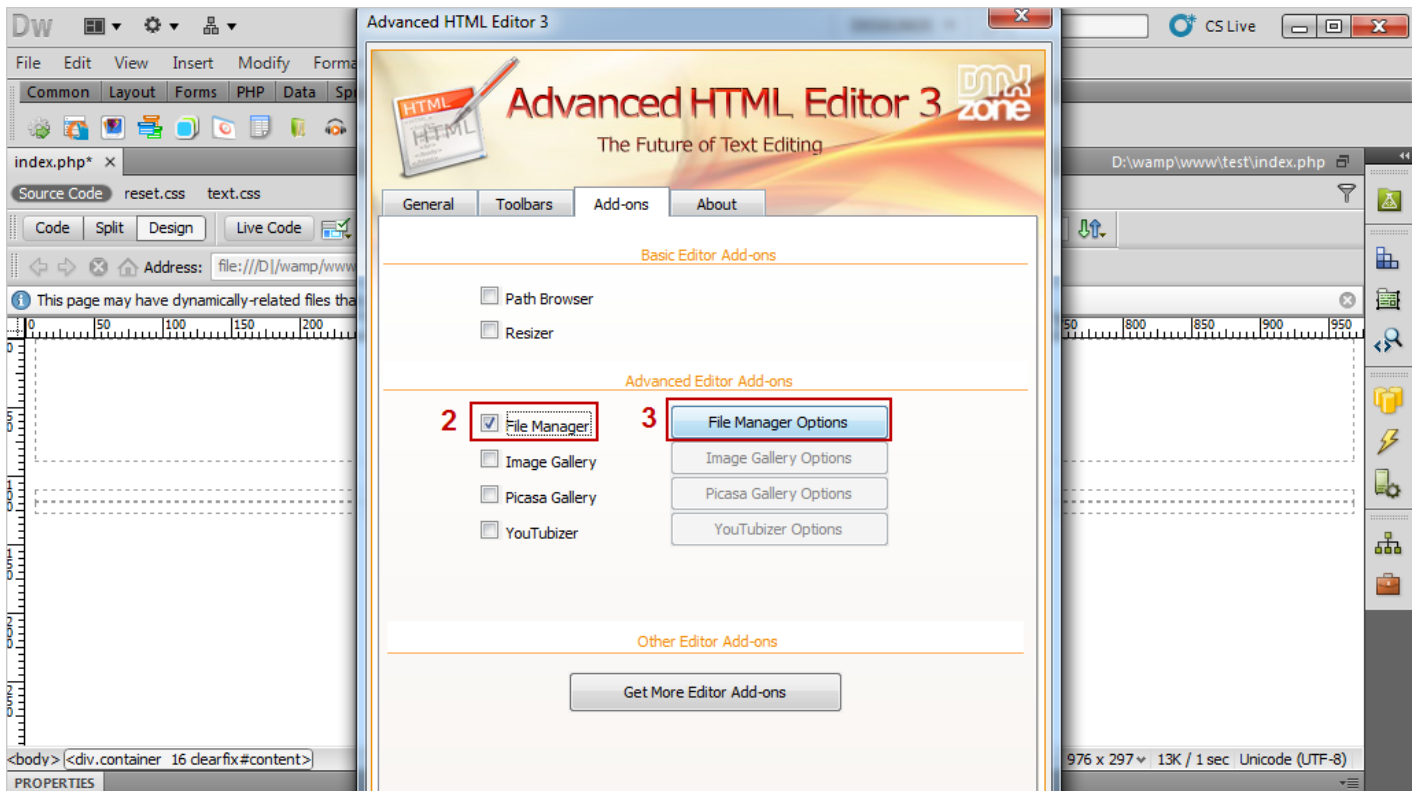
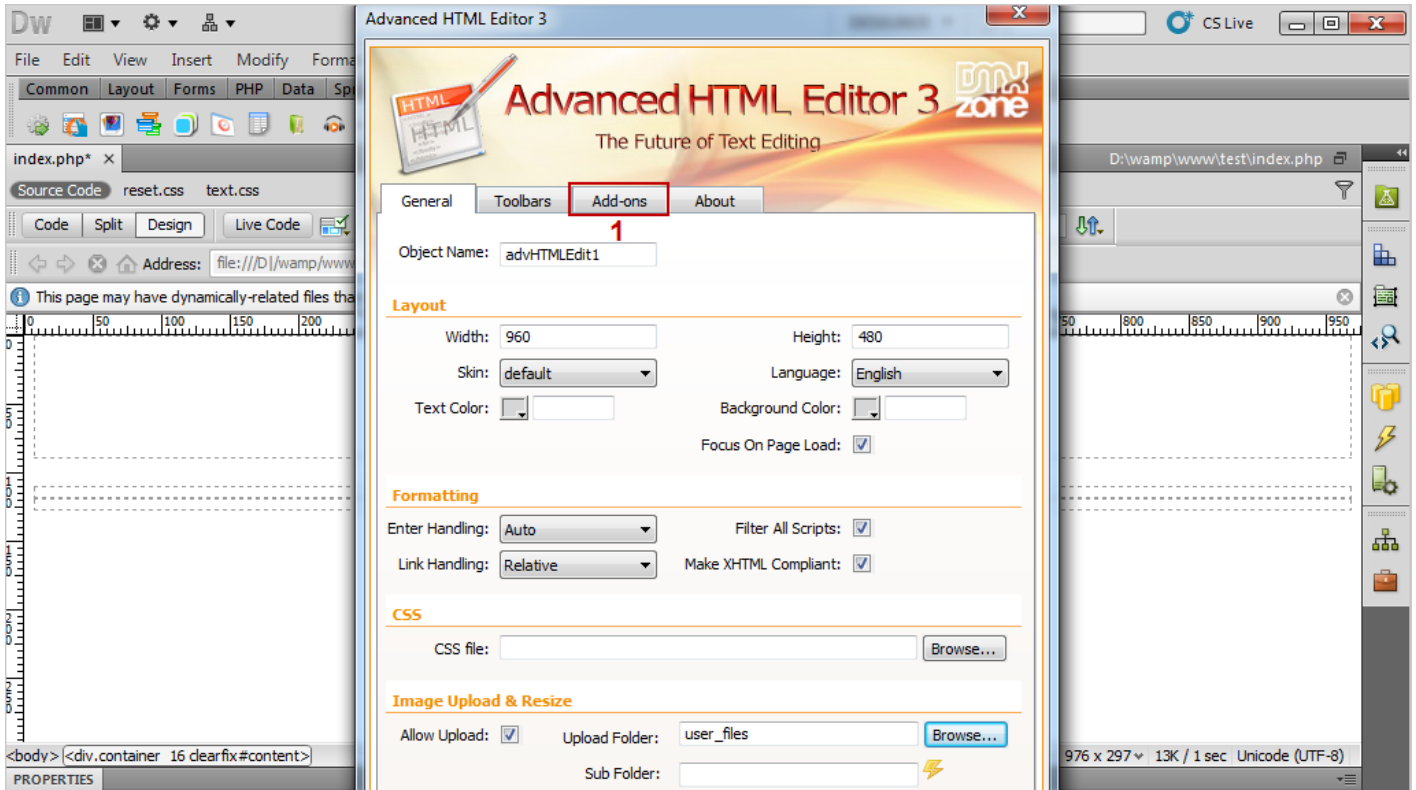
1. First, we are going to insert the **Advanced HTML Editor 3** on our page. Click the **Advanced HTML Editor 3** icon and the dialog will pop up.



- We are going to enable the **Image Upload** option (1) and select an **Upload Folder** (2). We will use this folder as a source folder for the **File Manager Add-on**.

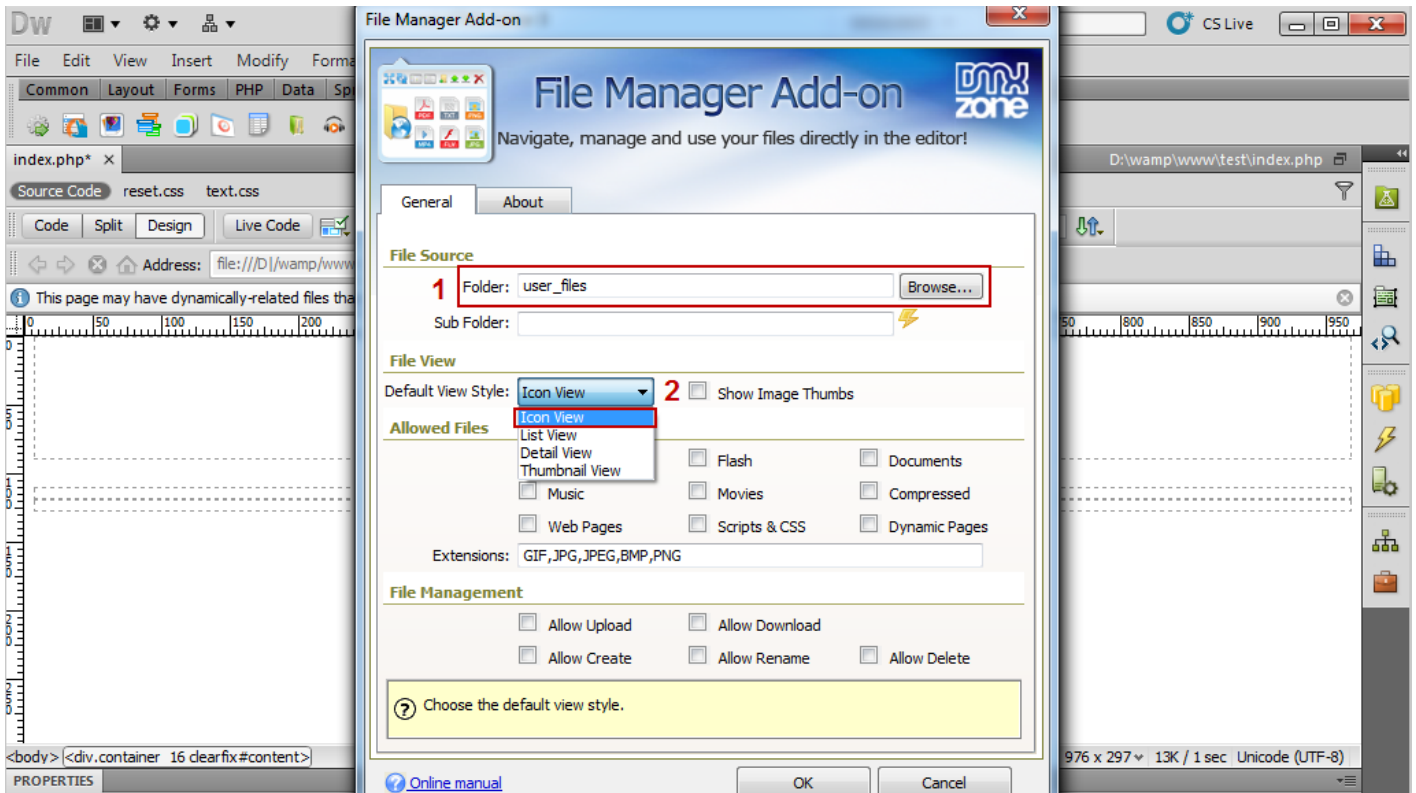


- In the **Add-ons tab (1)** we will select the **File Manager Add-on** and **enable** it to work with our HTML Editor (2) by clicking on the image **File Manager options button (3)**.





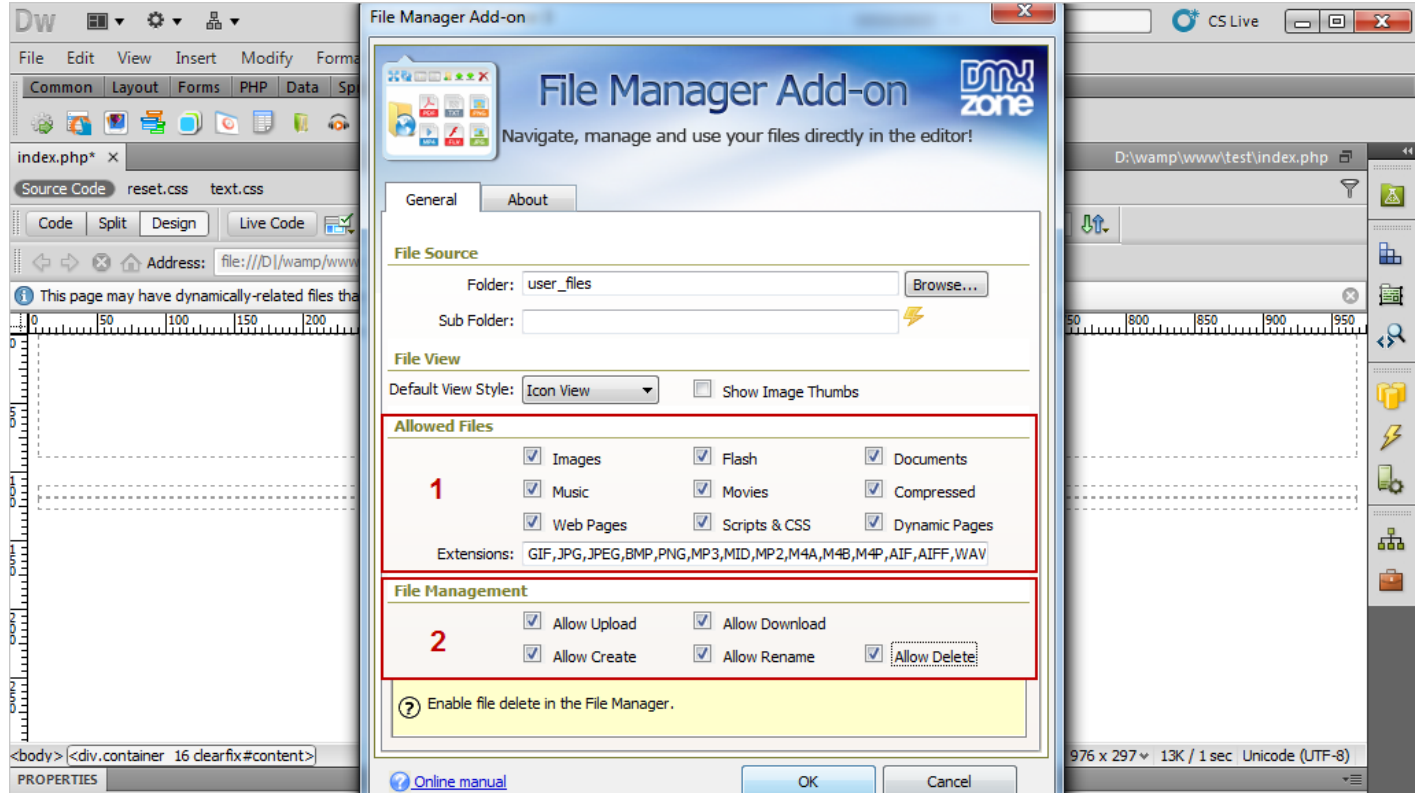
4. Now, we will customize the appearance of the **File Manager Add-on**. First, we need to select the **source folder (1)** for our files. Also we chose the **Icon view** for our files view style **(2)**.



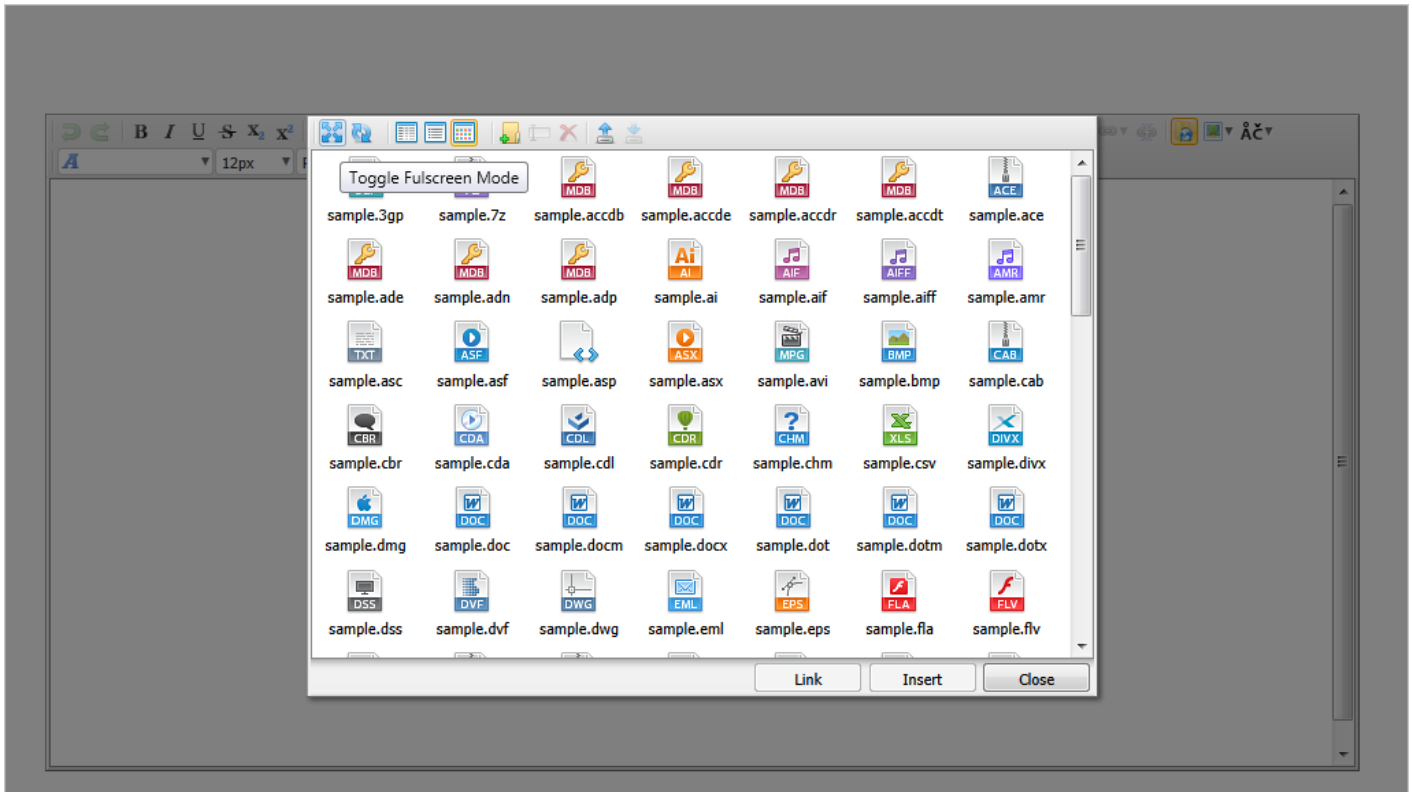


- We enable **all file types** to be shown in the **File manager (1)**, also we allow **upload, creating of new folders, download, file/folder rename** and **delete** of files **(2)**. When you're done, click OK.

\* In order to be able to upload files in your File Manager, you need to have **Pure PHP/ASP Upload** extension installed.



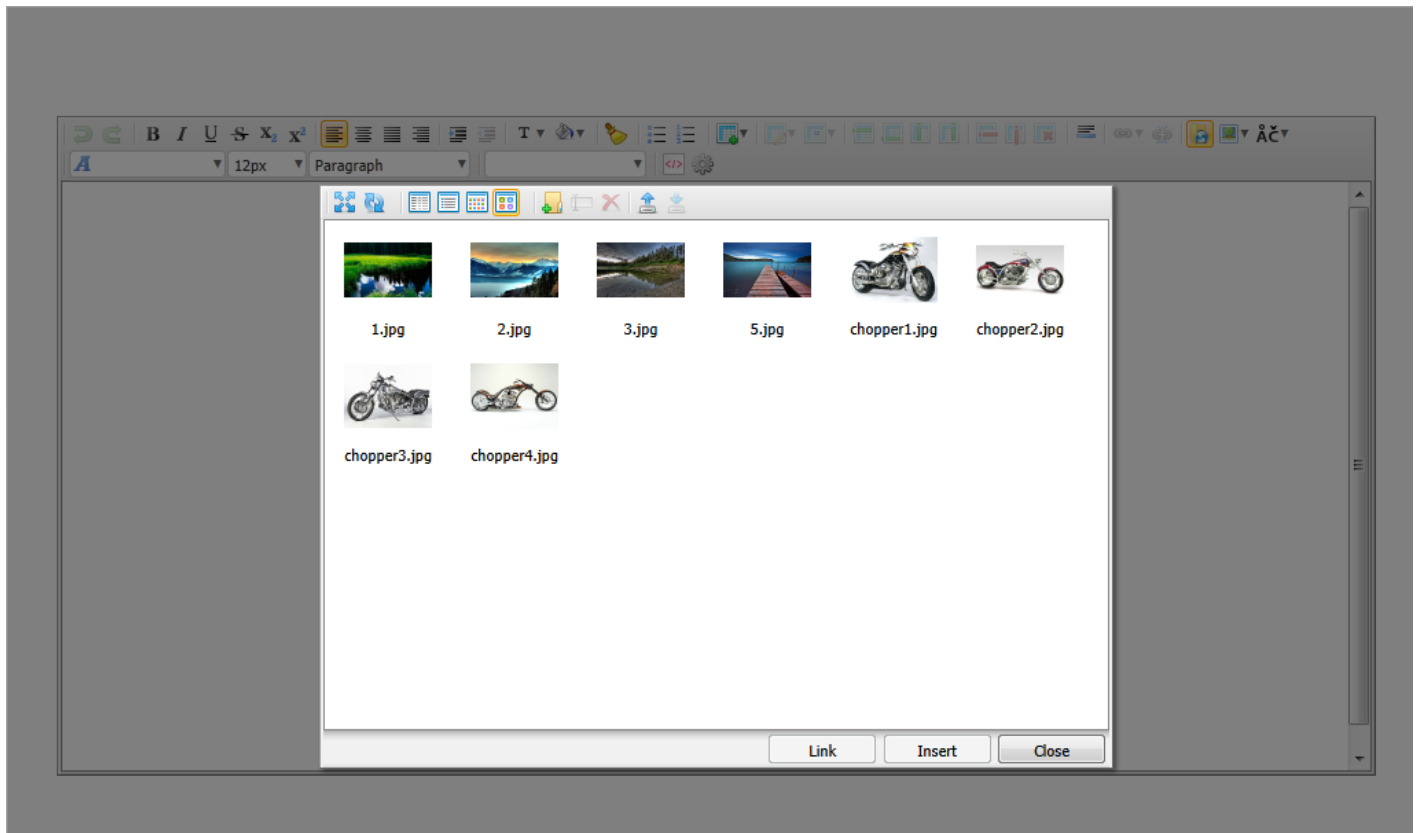
- Now, you can save your work and preview the **File Manager Add-on** in the browser.

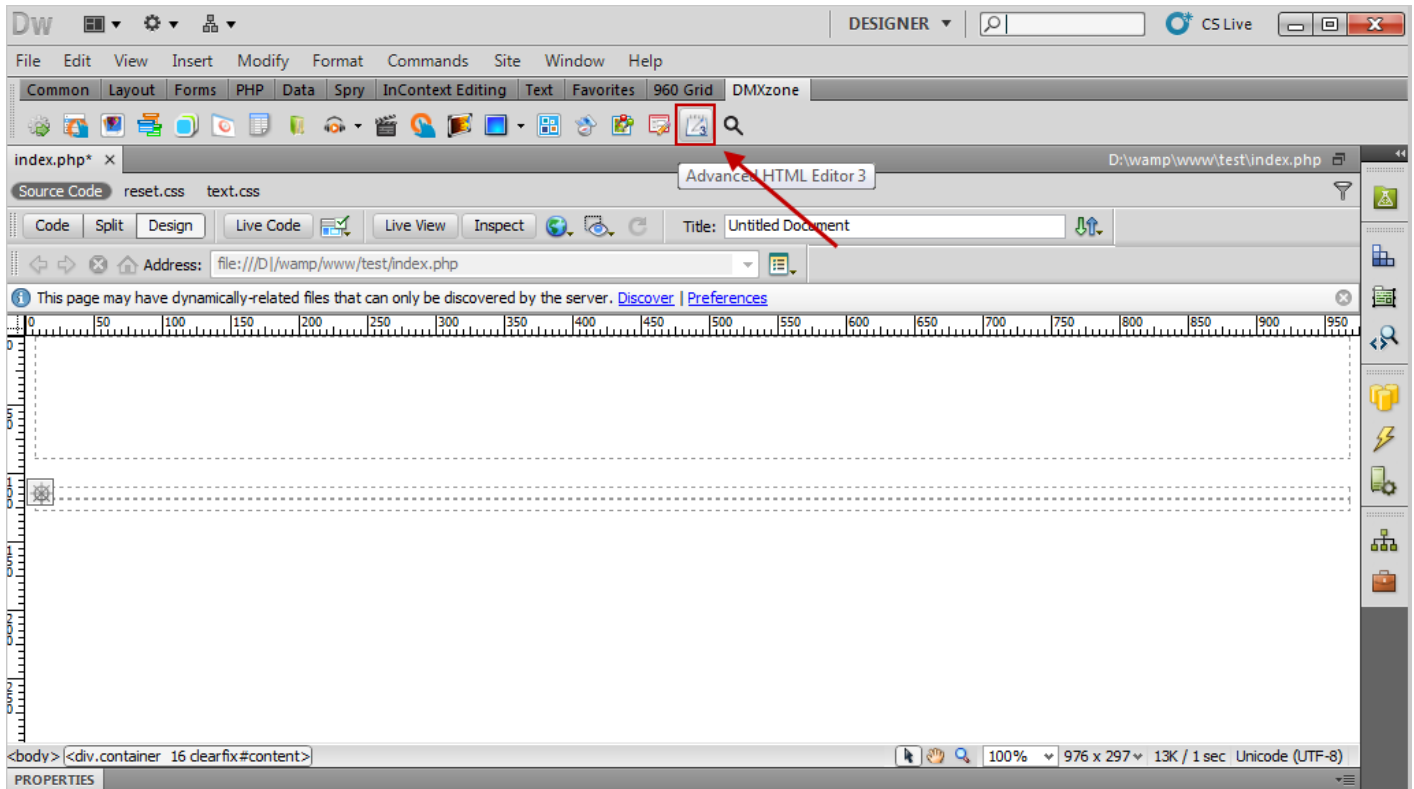

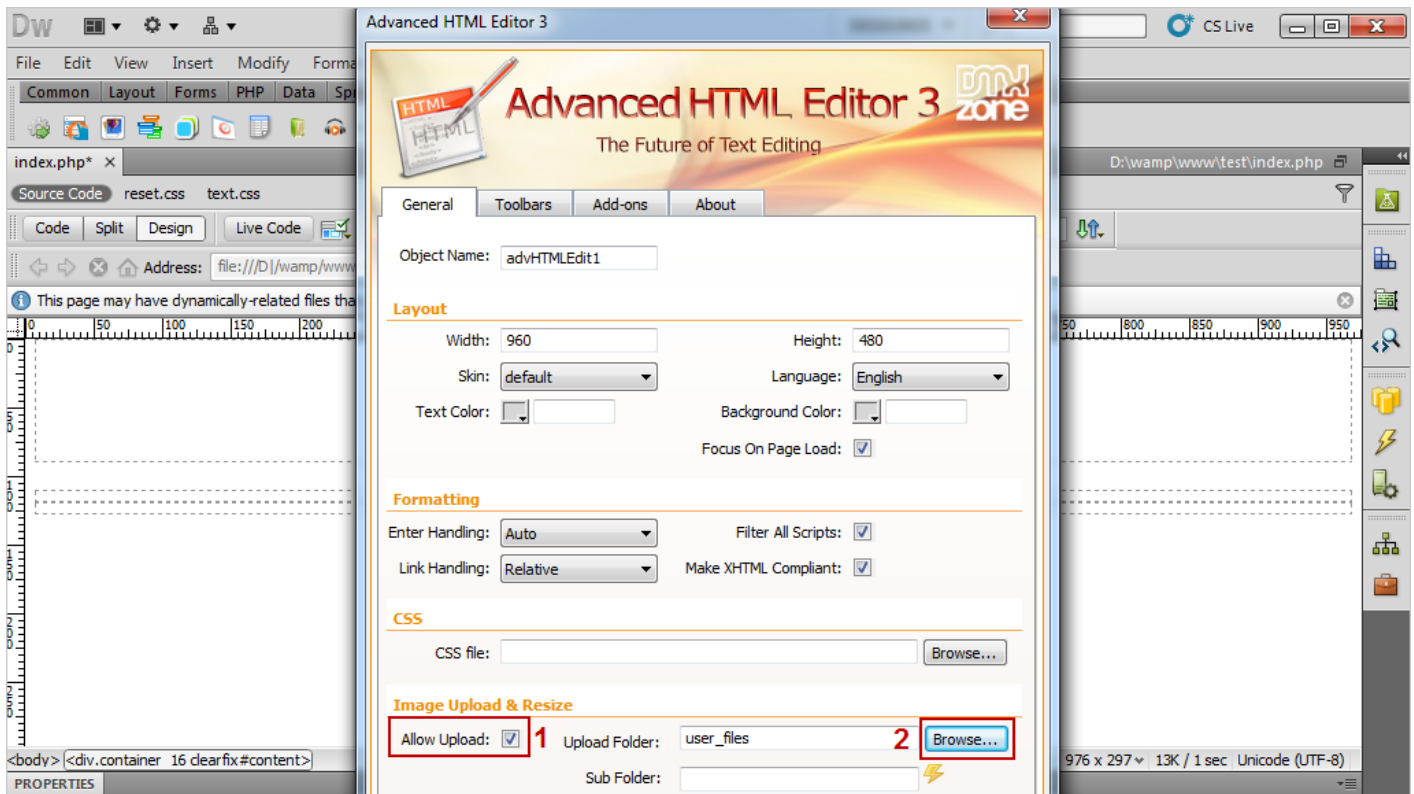


## How to do it:

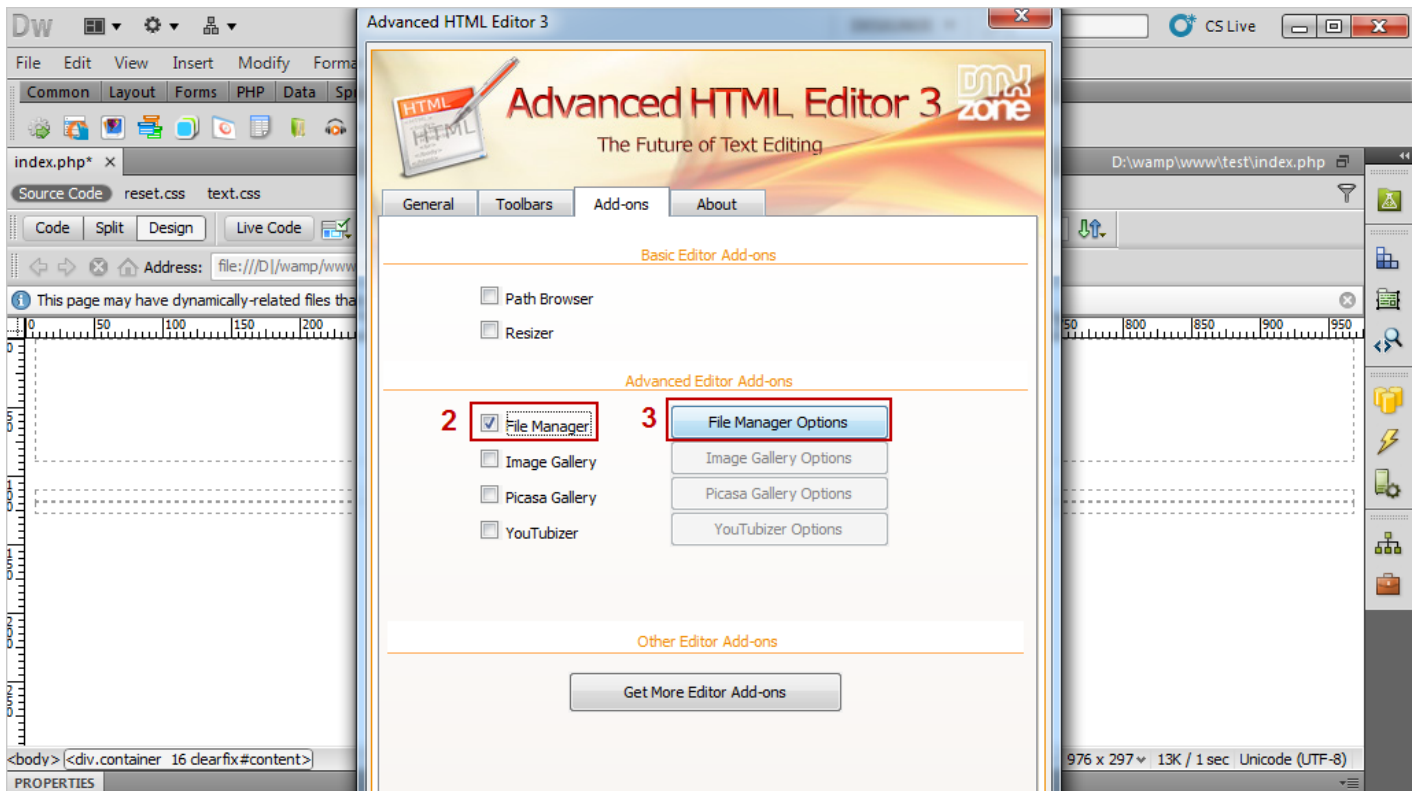
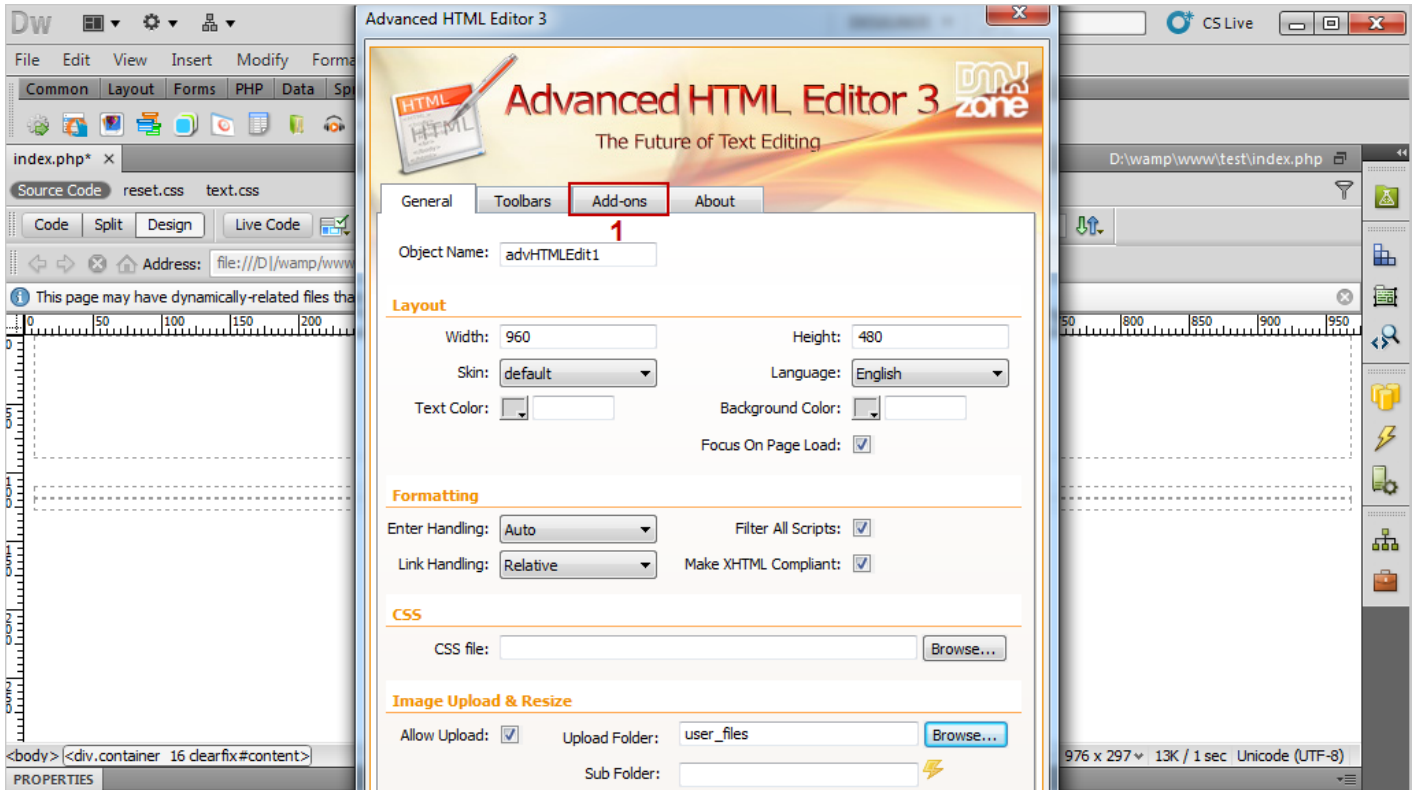
1. First, we are going to insert the **Advanced HTML Editor 3** on our page. Click the **Advanced HTML Editor 3** icon and the dialog will pop up.



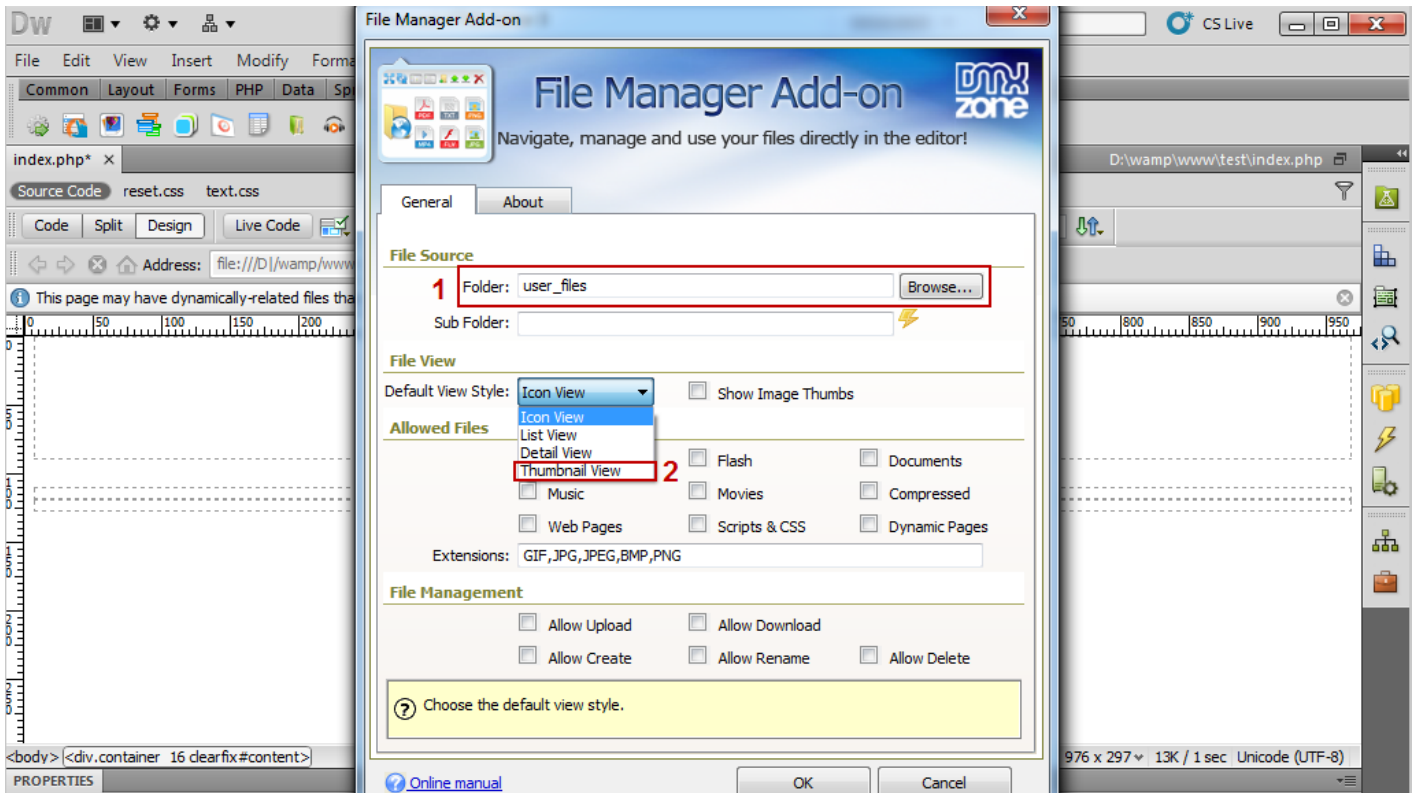

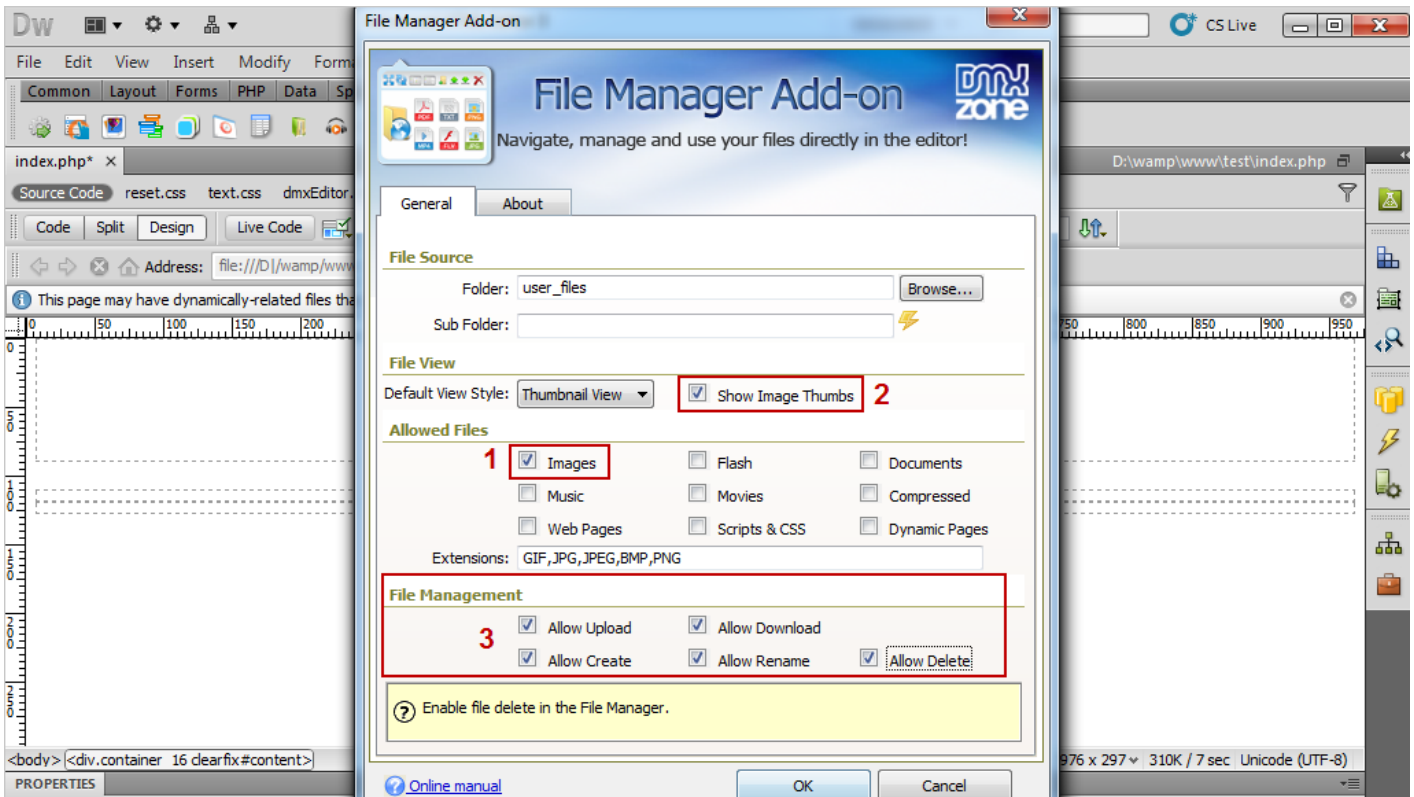

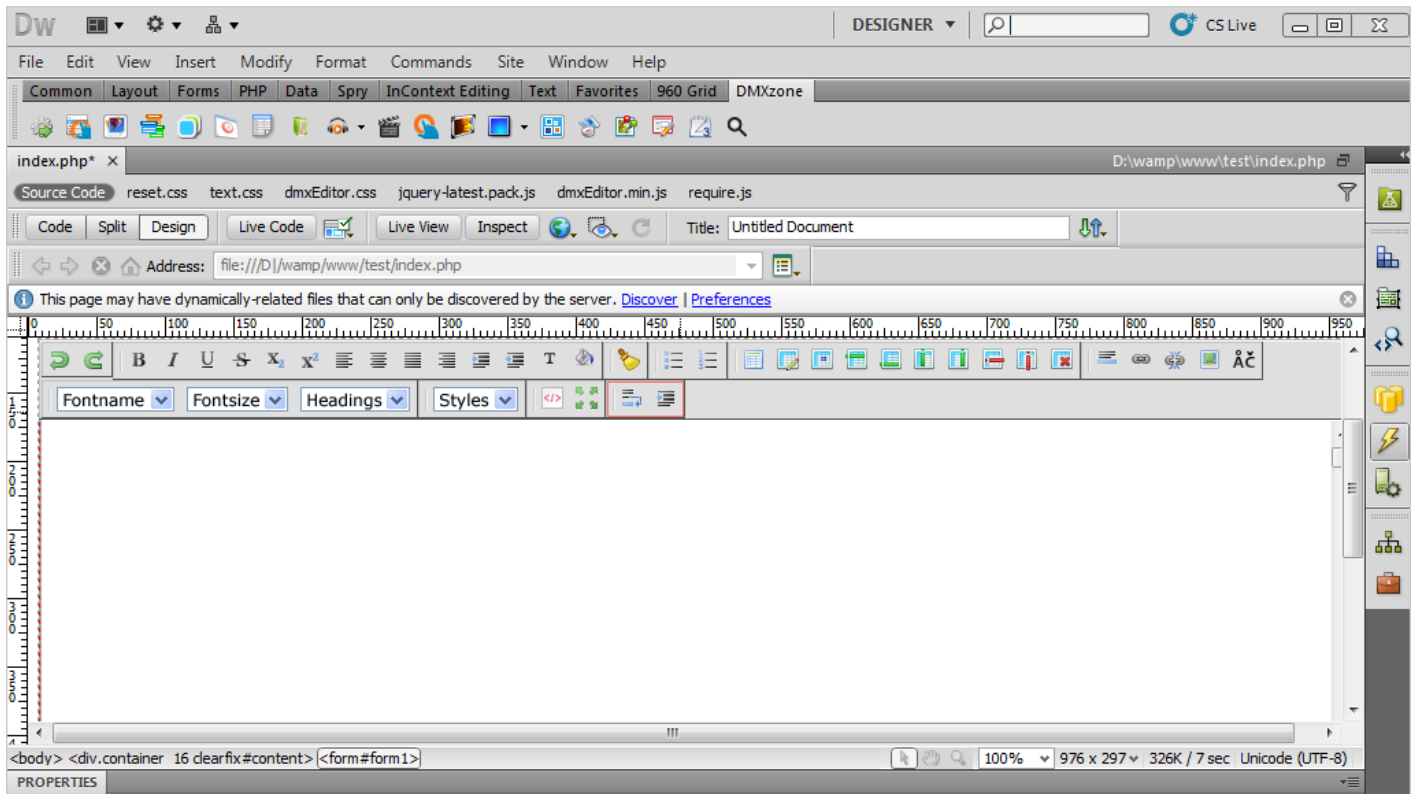


- We enable only **Images** under the allowed files section (1), check the **Show image thumbs** (2) and allow **all actions** under the File Management section (3).

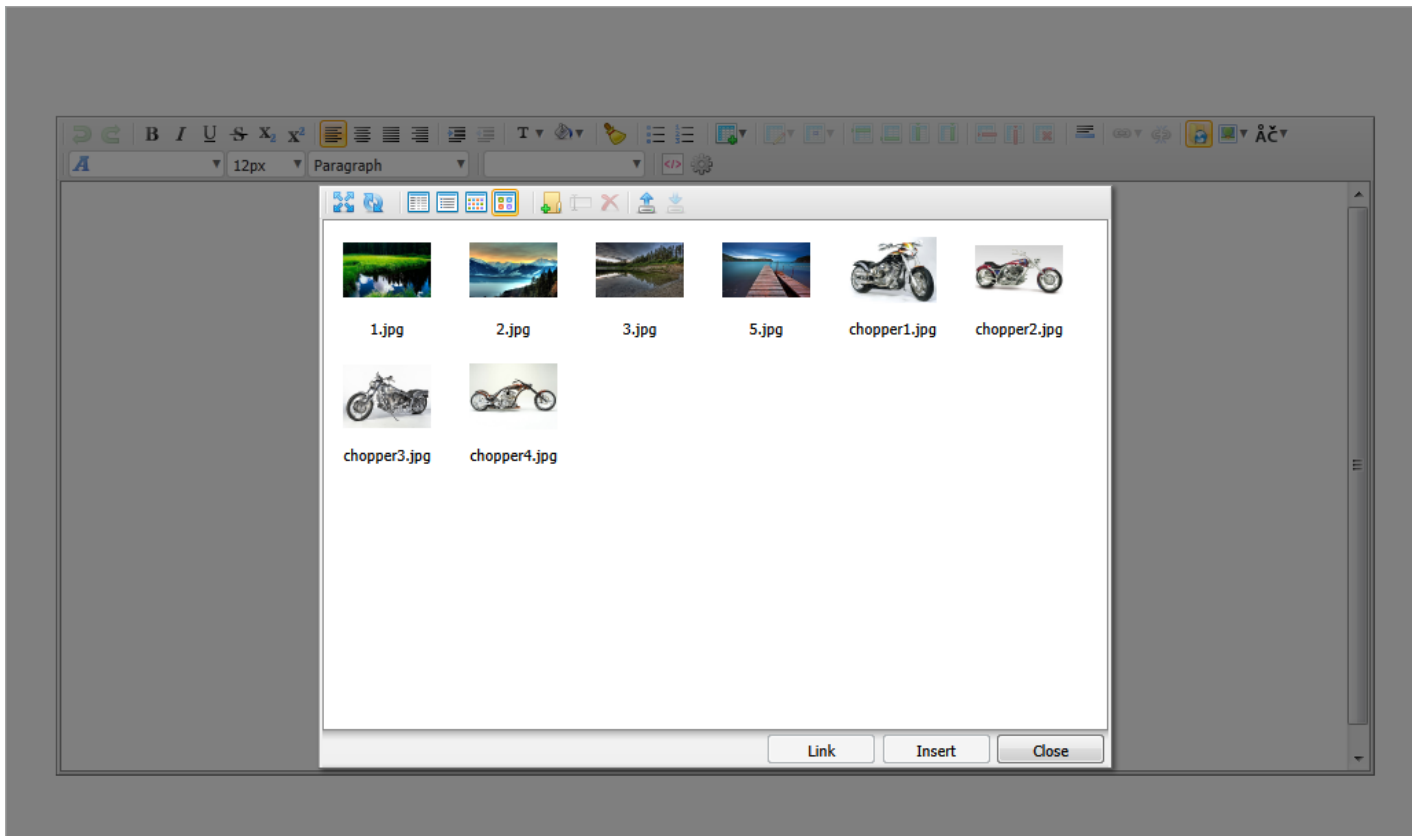


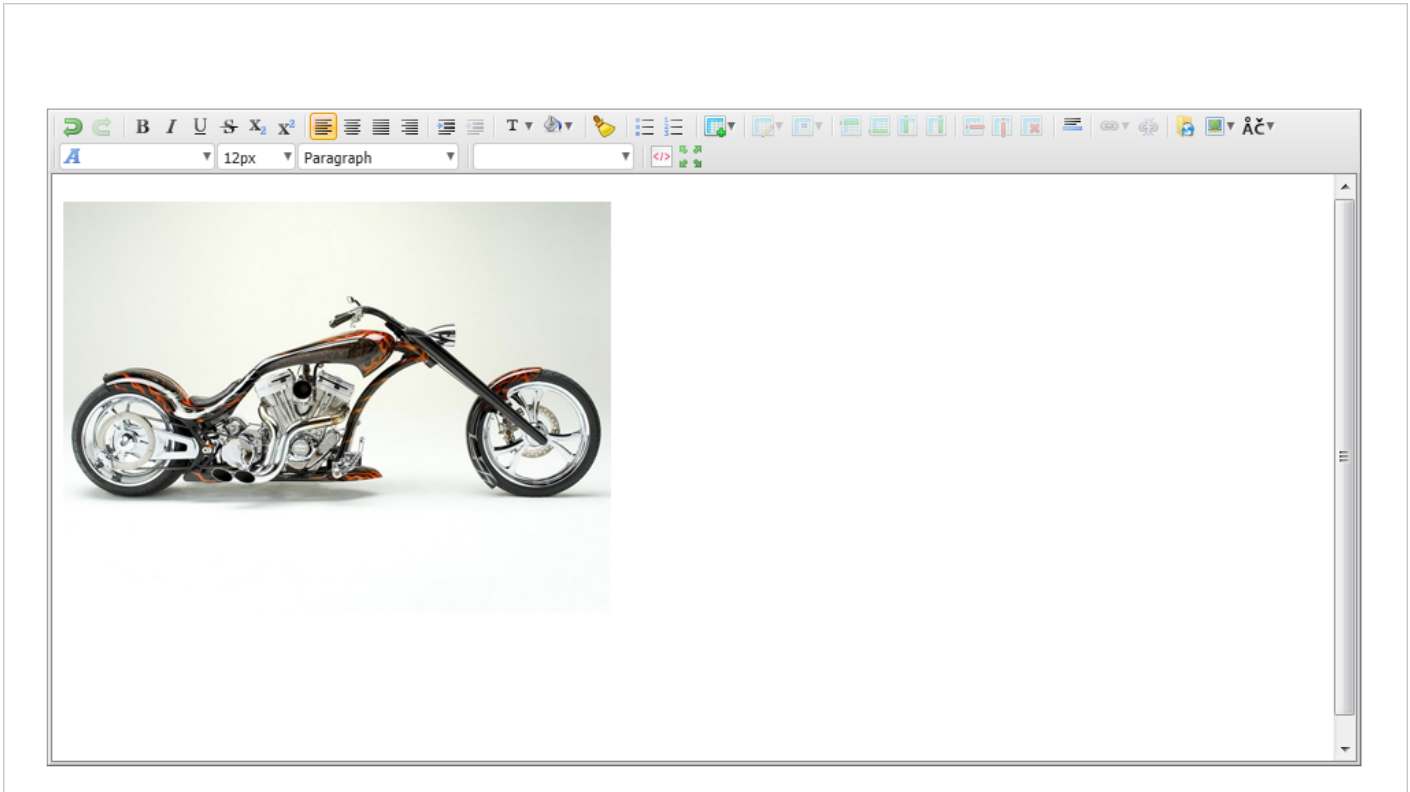


6. Now, save your work and preview the result in the browser.



7. Open the **File Manager** from your **Advanced HTML Editor 3** and you'll get a thumbnail preview of your images. Select an image and insert it in your editor.
